DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When have you faced setbacks in your life? Were you able to come back from it?
2. We all make mistakes in life, but how we handle them is what matters. Is your initial response to make excuses for mistakes, or to take ownership?
3. Regret means, "I'm sorry I got caught." Repent means, "I'm sorry and I want to change." When have you experienced each of these?
4. Accepting grace means, we accept that Jesus paid for our sins, so we don't have to keep trying to pay for them ourselves. Why is this so difficult for many people?
5. Shame is what Satan feeds us after we repent. Freedom is what Jesus gives us after we repent. Am I embracing shame or freedom more in my everyday life?

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
