Group Discussion

Scripture: John 3:1-8

Getting started: Which is more important to you: Independence or Dependence? Where do you fall on the spectrum between these two values:

- 1. Read John 3:1-2. Who was Nicodemus? Why do you think he came at night?
- 2. Read John 3:3-7. Why is being born again essential for salvation? What are the details of your own rebirth? Did the wind blow gently? Did a brisk breeze ruffle you? Did hurricane winds knock you down?
- 3. Read John 3:8. What metaphor does Jesus use to explain how the Holy Spirit works? Why is this such a good metaphor?
- 4. In our personal life and in the ministry of our church, we want to work and make things happen. Why must we value dependence on the Spirit over independence and doing things on our own strength?
- 5. What are obstacles to catching the wind?
