2 Samuel 11:1-27, Psalm 51:1-7

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- David had different seasons in life. Seasons of waiting, seasons of success, and seasons of struggle. How would you describe your current season of life?
- 2. How have you seen boredom and a lack of accountability lead to destruction? How have you seen this take place with kids, students, and adults? What can we do to prevent this from happening?
- 3. If what you're doing does not align with God's purposes, it eventually gets boring. So what are you contributing to that serves God's purposes?
- 4. David went through a progression we can easily fall into: Complacency leads to boredom. Boredom leads to sin. Sin leads to secrecy. Secrecy leads to shame. Have you experienced any stage of this progression in your own life?
- 5. Without a mission or something to fight for, we are ripe for failure. What mission or fight is God calling you to engage in?
- 6. Uriah died because of David's sin. This helped wake David up. Jesus died for your sin. How does this truth help wake you up and call you closer to God?

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
