GATHER, GROW, Go A Redemption Sermon Series (June 7, 14, and 21)

Jesus' invitation to the first disciples is the same invitation he makes to each of us. Matthew 4:19 says, "Come follow me, and I will show you how to fish for men." Jesus calls us to come to him (Gather), to follow him (Grow), and to fish for men (Go).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Have you ever faced something you felt totally unqualified to do? (A new phase of life, a new job, a new responsibility)? How did you face it? How did God reveal himself to you through that experience?
- 2. "Confidence does not come from discovering more about yourself. Confidence comes from discovering more about God." Where are you relying too much on yourself, when you need to rely on God?
- 3. God is not as interested in your ability as he is in your availability. What places in your life has God called you to go and make a difference? Have you answered him in obedience, or are you resisting that call in any way? Do you feel qualified, or are you depending on God to lead you through?
- 4. When we serve, we show others the goodness of God. How has someone displayed God's goodness to you by the way they served? What step do you need to take this week to serve others more and show them God's goodness?
