GATHER, GROW, Go A Redemption Sermon Series (June 7, 14, and 21)

Jesus' invitation to the first disciples is the same invitation he makes to each of us. Matthew 4:19 says, "Come follow me, and I will show you how to fish for men." Jesus calls us to come to him (Gather), to follow him (Grow), and to fish for men (Go).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Growth does not happen instantaneously, it happens over time. In what ways have you grown in this last season of your life? Do you trust Jesus more today than you did last year?
- 2. Peter Pan syndrome refers to one's inability to engage in behavior associated with adulthood. In other words, refusing to grow up. Have you ever seen this in others? Are there any areas of life where this may be true of you?
- 3. God doesn't want something from us, but something for us. When it comes to growth and spiritual disciplines, a lot of times we can approach them as something we have to do instead of something we get to do. What would you say your current posture is toward growth — have to or get to?
- 4. There are several spiritual disciplines we should practice, here are just a few we mentioned: (Studying God's word, Prayer, Solitude, Fasting, Participating in a group). How are you doing with each of these? Where are you strongest? Where do you need to take a step forward?
- 5. Like any muscle, our faith grows as we exercise it. We exercise it by serving others, and by sharing our faith. What is one thing you can do this week to exercise your faith? What will be challenging about this? When will you do it?
