2. Do you ever feel that by doing things God's way you're missing out? Why or why not?
3. Each son in the story cared more about their father's stuff than they cared about their father, they just pursued it in different ways. Do you ever find yourself wanting God's blessings more than you want a relationship with God?
4. When you think about God, how do you see him? How does Jesus' story of the two sons change your picture of God?
5. All of us are either the prodigal who strayed from home, or the prodigal who stayed at home. Which one do you identify with more?
6. What is God saying to you through his word? How and when will you respond?
