 - a. The shelter of the Most High - *Elyon*

- II. God’s Feathers Protect You – Psalm 91:3-10
 - a. Rescued from the fowler’s snare
 - b. Covered by God’s feathers
 - c. Nothing to fear
 - d. A peek at the world from under God’s wing

- III. God’s Angels Guard You – Psalm 91:11-16
 - a. Awesome promise! (But do not wrangle lions!)
 - b. Who twisted vv. 11-12? (What’s ironical about v. 13?)
 - c. The context of Jesus’ reply, and what happened next
