Good morning. Welcome to our Sunday morning service. Grace, Love. Glad that you're joining us this morning. And we're going to get right into our lesson this morning. Last week, we if you're looking for a title, I think we call it the God's definition of success. And we looked at the life of Joseph. Is that right? And how he was enslaved. We know if you go back and read about his life, we know that he was loved of his father and we know he had a dream. And God showed him a great plan, a great vision for his life. He was excited. No doubt. He was excited. Why wouldn't he be excited? Except he told everyone he knew about it, especially his brothers. And in that dream, he told them exactly what he saw. And he says it was an awesome dream I had last night. Let me tell you how this works. He's the youngest of all of them. He said, I see that I'm going to be this important person and all y'all going to be bowed down to me, including Father. No one said, Praise the Lord. Actually, they put him in a pit and sold him as a slave. So don't tell everything you know, even if you're right. Well, God, it didn't stop God's plan, even though he got real, you know, out of sync with, you know, how he could have handled it, should have handled it. But he was he was young. And in his immaturity, he made some decisions that that that, you know, put him in a place where I mean, we know where he ended up in the palace.

Right? So there is a way to go from the prison to the palace. He was in he was in prison for 13 years. You say? Well, I hope God doesn't give me a dream or a vision. Well, the vision came forth, but there was a time in preparation for him to take the place that God had for him. It doesn't mean it had to be prison. It just was prison. And so I don't want you going off say, well, God's got in prison you and break you up and break you down. That might be true spiritually in some dimension. In other words, there's going to be a making and the remaking of everyone. And, you know, just naturally thinking, you know, most people never grow in their life spiritually for sure. Very few people grow when everything's easy. Most growth actually takes place during difficult times. We had this way in America, just like this weekend is the three day weekend. So a lot of people mean I'm gone. Well, you're supposed to stay because it's Labor Day weekend. You just stay and pull weeds or something. I don't I don't know where. It's not beach. It's pull weeds. No, I'm just joking. But anyway, he went to the palace and we read the scripture. We won't go back there. In Genesis 39, it says, though he was in prison, this is this is how God viewed it. Just when you when you read the scripture said Joseph was in prison and God said he was a prosperous and a successful man.

And so we contrasted that between the world's view of success versus God's view of success. This meeting coming up in Trussville is called the Summit. When large corporations get together with their stockholders and with other leaders, they talk about large ideas. So there was a reason for moving it away from the normal, be honest with you. Not just because it was halfway in between another church. It was moving the venue away so God could talk to leaders. So everyone's invited. So but we're not trying to accommodate. We're not bringing someone from Wales and asking to be through in 45 minutes because there's only two meetings. And so it's going to be really, really good anyway. So I'm y'all ready to go to that next level? Well, the truth is, you'll never straighten out your life until you straighten out your mind. Amen. And we're always talking about the mind, right? Because Proverbs 23 says a man thinketh in his heart that's who he is. Amen. That's not. I didn't write that. As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he. And where the mind goes, the person follows the body. Go right with the mind. We won't go there. But. Matthew. 1233 1233 It says a tree is known by its fruit. The same is true with your life and my life. Because thoughts bear fruit. All thoughts bear fruit. Good or bad. And so when we have emotional issues, which we'll talk about again this morning somewhat, and we have the census that talk to us. Just know this, that the word of God not attached to your soul, your mind, will and emotions is the is the will.

They will. In other words, if you don't attach the word to your soul, to your mind, your will and your emotions, it will not affect your soul and your body and your and your. The person will follow always their mind. And I came across this story a number of years ago and it was a really it's true. In fact. But it's a really good analogy. They'll say that what I want to say this morning, I don't know if he was the originator, but I and he might be Myles Munroe. He's in heaven now. He said there's two animals that the creator identified himself with in the Bible. One is the Eagle and the other one. The second one is the lion. I want to talk to you about the lion for just a moment. Of course, we know the eagle is the king of the bird kingdom. In the lion is the is the is the king of the animal kingdom. How many y'all would agree with that? That the lion is known as the king of the animal kingdom? So it begs the question to say this. Why is the lion considered the king of the jungle? I'm just reading you what he wrote here. He said, Why is the lion considered the king of the jungle? He's not the tallest. Giraffes are taller. He's not the biggest because elephants are bigger. He's not the heaviest. Hippos are heavier. He's not the smartest in the kingdom. Animal. Kingdom. Because hyenas are smarter. He's not the most intelligent.

Chimpanzees are more intelligent. When an elephant sees a lion, an elephant will run. Even though he's bigger. He's. He's bigger. He's stronger, he's smarter. And he's more powerful than this cat. The lion. The elephant is a victim because of how he thinks. When the lion sees an elephant, he charges toward the elephant. Because when he sees the elephant, he believes he's found lunch. Now, what's wrong with that? The lion is the king of the jungle because he has a different mindset. He has a different attitude. The lion's action reflects the way that he thinks. His mindset makes all the animal kingdom respect the lion more than any other animal. So he went on to say, Picture this. Two persons, same skills, same same degrees, same economic conditions, same location, same problem identified by both. One thinks lunch and the other thinks danger. How about that? So your mindset is the result of your beliefs and your actions reflect what we believe. We become what we believe and we limit ourselves by what we believe. Anyway, that's a good little story. So our lives today. Your life, My life, all of us today, they're always. They're always moving in the direction of your most dominant thoughts. That's why it's so important when we talk about renewing the mind. And when you hear a scripture that, you know, sometimes sometimes you we have a tendency to quit here and say, I know that knowing that and doing that was two different things. I know some things about. I know some things about, you know, good nutrition. I know some things.

How much would you pay if you could just drive by saying, Look, I'm going to give you a I'm going to give you a 90 day, you know, I'll pay my membership and I'm going to drive by here three times a day and just and just breathe it in. And what's your goal? Well, I want to lose £50 and I want to build this. And, you know, I want to. Okay. But then when you come by here, you know, put your arms like this, you know, breathe in and shake your legs a little bit, you know, And I want somebody, you know, like this and like that. Well, that is going to be another \$100. Okay, well, I'll drive by five times a day. I'm going to drive by the health food store, you know, and and I'll be healthy. Then I can go home, eat pizza because I already drove by the health food store. Wouldn't that be awesome? You know what I described to you? Maybe heaven, because you don't want to miss that. Do you know? You don't want to miss that. So. But we are today the result of our thoughts in the past. And who you become in the future will be determined by your thoughts today.

Where are you? Where you are today in your life and your is based on how you was thinking yesterday. That's just a biblical truth and you will be tomorrow based on how you're going to believe today. If this is church to you today, if you're punching the clock, if you're making yourself feel better that I came to church. We're glad that you're here, but it probably won't benefit you a whole lot. He said, the truth will set you free. But you have to you have to accept the truth, believe the truth, and adjust your life to truth. You have to be willing to release, let go and say, I have believed this all my life. My family believed this. And but the Word of God says this. Yeah, but, Grandmama. Well, thank God. So what are you going to do about your life? I mean, there's things that. That we walked along in years. This is the way it's supposed to work for anyone. Not fivefold ministry. I mean, there's things I preached, you know, 30 years ago. I don't agree with myself. Why? Because I worked. I went further and I saw more revelation. Most of the time was progressive. Amen. You see this and you see that? You see the church coming to such a place. You know, or Roberts, in his day, you know, had of course, you know, he's known for having a great healing ministry.

People would come under the tent by, you know, over 10,000 people and they be healed. And his ministry started because he needed healing. He was on the death bed as a kid. Brother Hagan was on a deathbed. Brother Hagan was healed after being in the bed for 16 months, had three diseases. Either one was going to take his life. He was 16 years old and he said never ran and played like a like a regular teen or child. And he had bad blood, had a bad heart. He had paralysis and by all medical means, he had to leave. He had to leave. He had no spiritual help. Everyone told him, you know, every time he was trying to tell him, he said, I only had till like 1030 in the morning because he says, you know, my mind was going this way. Then my vision would be and, you know, I lose good vision and I couldn't read the Bible, he says. He says, And I had so much paralysis, he says, Sometimes it took me ten minutes just to turn one page over my Bible. And all he wanted to know when he found certain things. Is this true? So pastors would come. He asked for pastors, and he says some of them never come. And he got discouraged. One finally came and he and all he wanted to know was he found this truth in Mark.

11 2324 and he wanted to know, does it mean what it, what it looks like it means? And he was trying to say that and he was saying a and the pastor just grabbed his hand and just went like this. He said, It's all right, boy. It'll all be over real soon. Which is what every 116 years old wants to hear. With no help. By God. Amen. Come on, he said. You know, it didn't take 16 months to get healed. He said it just took 16 to think, right? Even with no help. And like I said before, I'm not trying to endorse him. I'm just saying. But and even though it affected our lives. But every four hours, a new Greymouth church starts somewhere in the world every four hours. From a teenager dying on deathbed. Now, the Lord didn't say, I'm going to heal you and you're going to do this and you're going to do that. And he didn't show them what the life was going to look like. He was just trying to live. Kirsten was talking about because she's wearing some of the stuff and, you know, he could hear him in there. He could hear his mom and his grandparents and the pastor and the pastor was just there trying to console the family. And they were just, you know, he was praying for the family pre-death to comfort them because he was going to die.

And then they asked him, his parents and grandparents, his mother, his dad left his mom. His mom had a nervous breakdown. There was other kids that had to come live with the grandparents. So he's totally bedridden, but he could hear them in there planning his funeral. And the pastor who came to see him, he was trying to, you know, comfort them. So they all accepted he was going to die. And by natural by natural thinking, he would have died. He was supposed to die. But God. And so they asked him. They said, Well, what song would you want to. What song would you want would you want sung at your funeral? He was just trying to get out in words that they could understand as Mark 11 2324 mean what it says. But they said, Well, what songs would you like sung at your funeral? And he he said, Well, I don't know. He says, he said, I don't guess I'll be there. He said, Well, why don't y'all just sing something y'all like that's like, I can't get no one to answer my question. He finally got some understanding of Mark 11 2324 and he says, oh, oh, I see it, I see it. In other words, I'm supposed to believe that I'm healed while I'm laying here in the bed with paralysis, with a bad heart and bad blood? I'm supposed to believe that I'm healed even when it looks and feels like this in the Holy Ghost.

Holy Spirit says, he says Now you believe. Now you see it, Now you believe. And he was excited. And no one was in the room with him, paralyzed from the waist down for a year and a half. And then the Holy Spirit said, he says, you know, most people are up at 1030 in the morning. In other words, now faith has to have some action. He said, that's right. So he didn't call for help. They had a little mechanism. He tried to pull himself up sometimes. So it took him quite a while because he was trying to move his legs. He was trying to pull them like this with his hand. He's trying to get them off the side of the bed. Took over an hour or so to do that. And he said when he when he did it and he pulled something to stand up because he hadn't stood up in a year and a half, you can imagine the weakness of the body. He said it felt. So wonderful and hurt so much at the same time. In other words, all the nerves in his body, you know, like with little needles and feeling begin to come into his body because he saw something that he didn't see the day before. And he had to change. He had to exchange information. For Revelation. And I'm getting ahead of myself.

But most people looking for a breakthrough and God is the God of breakthrough. But what you really need is transformation. You need to transform yourself from information to revelation. You you need exchange information for revelation. And and I'll let me say this. You can have the right information, but it's not relevant to you because you heard it from someone else. But you haven't made it church yet. In other words, you could see a truth and it be the truth. And you could say, Well, that's awesome, that's good. But you never put it into practice. So what you're trying to live you're trying to live off secondhand information. Because you never made it yours. Once again, Brother Hagan, I'll move on. He said. He said even in the ministry, he said most ministers. Most ministers. Not the laity. Most ministers, he said. They're their echoes and not voices. In other words, or most people are thermostats or I mean, they're not they're not the thermometer. They're thermal. You know, In other words, God wants you to be a thermostat in the sense of that back wall. There's a there's a thermostat on it. We can set the air or the heat anytime we want to, right. For what we want to. Now, that doesn't produce the air conditioning. It's on the other side of that wall. But when we say we're we want colder air, we want it warmer, then we put the information there and it gets in touch with it gets in touch with the compressor and the air conditioner on the other side.

And he says they're asking for more air. Let's go. Get to work. In other words, you're the one who sets the tone. You're the one who creates the atmosphere. Because it's who. Who's in you. Christ is in you. Amen. Where does the Holy Spirit live? In us. But the church has been busy for at least a decade or two. You know, writing songs about All Fall Down on Us. Oh, come. Oh, God, I'm so thirsty and dry. Fill me. Well, but if you and I don't mean to demean anything, I'm just saying. But it's hard to find good music in the scripture. You can find something that's emotional, that moves you, but it's just most of it. It's not scriptural. I mean, you read the stuff they're putting out now, it's just, Oh, there was an ocean and a tree and the the mist just washed over me. There was sin I could see, but God came down. So it's like, shoot that thing in the head. It has nothing to do who you are or what Jesus has done. Andrew Wong said this way, He says, I think he says like this. He says most people believe God can do anything, but they don't believe he's done very much. That is the most true statement.

You know, Pastor, for 2 or 3 decades and you'll say, I know, I know. That's a fact. That's a fact. Someone called me that day and I had one of these calls in years and they said, and I think they've been here twice. And they said, Pastor, how come you ain't called us? I said, called you for it. How come you ain't been checking on us? I'm like. For what? Not to name any names. And I said. I'm not your pastor. Oh, yeah. You're a pastor. I said no. You came twice. One time you got there ten minutes where It was over. You've been one and a quarter times. And I didn't do this my third. You don't take me that many words no more. As you get older, you'll use less words to get where you're going. A whole lot less words. And I said, This is the way it works for me anyway. I said, Until you take and until you take advantage of my public time, don't call me on my phone and take my private time. This is available publicly at this time. And if you don't take advantage of that, don't think I'm looking for you. If you if you have something, you need something, you call me. Because I do care and I'll be a part of that. Well, I thought pastors are just supposed to keep in touch with all the sheep. I said, Well, you thought wrong.

Hmm. I'll see. If I was one of those shepherds, I would have a cane with a crook on it, and it'd be around your neck, and I'd be snatching you from left to right all day long. And you wouldn't like that. Then you'd be mad at me for sure. She said, Well, I don't want to think about you. She said, I'll lie. She said, Boy, you tell it straight. I said, You want it another way? See, when I was 20 and I thought someone 80. I thought, man, that's way out there, right? Because two plus six is eight. Woo! Can you see that far? But six plus two is eight, too. So you see the you know, you see it kind of you know, it won't take as much time to say it because you want you want to help people, but you want it to be relevant, not just make them feel good. Not make them just like you or me to like you. I mean, you know who doesn't want to be liked? But, you know, sometimes when you go. I've had doctors who were I've seen doctors who were great doctors, but they had no bedside manner whatsoever. They were just write down. Rude. Rude. I had to have a surgery. What was beginning of this year or sometime last year, a kidney stone had him 20 years before that. This one they said you ain't going to pass is too big.

So we'll have to shock it. You know, all that kind of stuff. And I got there. They give me some things for pain before I got there and praise the Lord. I'm glad I knew some scripture. Most women tell you who had who had babies and kidney stones. They said, we've had children. We've had kidney stones. We'd have a child in there. They don't help me right now to hear that. Oh, my God. Don't tell me that. And and I got there to the the hospital, you know, and they was getting me ready. And, boy, here it come again. And you don't know what to do. I mean, you're hot, you're cold, you're hurting. I mean, you just want to. I mean, you could bite. You could bite a tenpenny nail in half. You just with your teeth. And this, the surgeon come in and I'm just in pre, you know, pre-op, and he just comes in having a bad day and I wasn't with it too well, and he's asked me all kind of technical stuff. I said, oh he said now is the is it on the left or right. Is the is the. He's asking me things that he thinks I'm supposed to know. And even in that condition, I said, I don't know. Is it not in my chart. I know there's a part that he wants to know that we're talking about the same thing.

But when I got through, everybody was apologizing for him and a guy came up and he had on shirt like Nathan does, had an auburn shirt, and he walked up and he was real nice and he said, I'm sorry about that. He's usually not like that. He says. And I said, It's no big deal. I said, He says, I'm going to be with you. I'm the anesthesiologist. I'm going to put you to sleep. And I said, War, eagle, war. Some people say say other ways. I said, I said, You good at this? I said, Yeah. I said, I said, I'm an Alabama fan, but War Eagle, man, I'm all for you. I said, let's let's do that quick. Let's do that quick. So they put you to sleep and then they had this machine that comes just shock. Shock, shock. They're trying to break the stone in small pieces. It was a ten millimeter and they're trying to get it down to 1 or 2 fragments. Then you just pass it out of your body. But they left me a five millimeter stone after all the surgery, which I had to pass at home, I sent them the bill. They haven't responded yet with a check. Amen. And I passed it pretty much with these. And I knew what it was and felt it was coming. And because we had to go back in two weeks later or a week later, I had to do a checkup with the doctor and he did an x ray.

Oh gosh, he says. They still left five millimeters there. He says, I may have to send you back in there. He said, if it ain't passed by tomorrow, I will send you back in there. So he did all kinds of things. It was going to make it pass, but it didn't pass, he says, But I want you to come in the morning. We're going to do this, this and this, because I'm going to try to make it move before I close today. I said, Why? He says, Because I don't want you to be out tonight and not have any help. He says, I'm going to try to make this thing move, and I won't go with what he did to make it move. But it did. After he closed. And all of a sudden this all of a sudden I mean, just I was just sitting there and that initial kind of like a well, you could call it fear, but just like the panic of that extreme pain's coming and they're closed and die and the surgery is over and. All of a sudden, the Holy Spirit gave me a scripture that he knew. I knew that, you know, and y'all are familiar with it here, but I've never heard but one person ever preached on it. And this is in the book of Jeremiah.

And it says, he says, I will break up the the stubborn places. He says he said, my word is like a hammer that will break up the stubborn pieces. The amplified says my words like a hammer that will break up even the rocks. Even the stubborn rocks will break it. Even those of the most stubborn resistance. And they'll break it into pieces. And I was like, That's right. I went and grabbed my Bible and I read it and I said, That's it. I says, This stone is going to be broken up into small fragments. And in 20 minutes later, it completely passed in little bitty, bitty granules, all that. And then the Holy Spirit said to me, he said, You know, that also works pre-op. Pre operations. I'm like, Oh, so it's good not just to have information, but to have revelation. All right. Let me move on real quickly now. Most people because you want to think like the line, remember, because he's he's the one who's comes and he's he's considered the the king of the jungle, king of the animal kingdom because because of his mindset. How he thinks. You're you're going to succeed or not succeed based on not just your work ethic, not just because you have a degree or don't degree, but because you how you think. True. True story in America. And I'm not saying you shouldn't get education. I think you should get I think you should go to school.

I think you should get educated. You should take advantage of whatever's available to you. But the honest to God truth, if you ever want to do a study on this, the A student generally works for the B student who works for the C student because the C student's one who owns a company in America. That's just that's just true. It's not true for everyone. But generally speaking, the B to C student is the one who had the dream, who had the idea, who had the work ethic, and he put it into practice when everything said, you know, you would never succeed at this level in doing that because, you know, you wasn't the valedictorian. You didn't graduate top of your class. You didn't go to all these schools, you didn't have all these things. That's why I've been asked by so many times through the years. Pastors would ask me, said, How do you start a church? And I just said, I don't know the way. Well, how did you start church? I said, By trying not to start one. I did everything I could to tell God this is the bad idea. I mean, I know you know everything, but you've been real busy. And if you just look at your records a little bit longer, you can see I'll be a bad choice for you. Because I can look around and see people a whole lot more qualified.

And you never know what something is and you never know where you are and things until you're faced with a situation, whether it's, you know, Daniel in the lion's den or is the three Hebrew men, Shadrach, Meshach and a Billy goat, I mean the Bendigo, you never know until the fire comes where you are. The test. The test will reveal where you are. The test will write. It's the same thing nationally in school. When they give you a test on Friday and it wasn't to tear you down. They're just trying to see, communicate and say, are you are you you know, in other words, are is the teaching going forward getting to you or are you receiving are you accepting? Are you are you learning? That's what the test reveals to them. And if you didn't study, you didn't pay any attention. The test. I guess it does. It might tear you down, but it really it just reveals where we are and we need that. I mean, you got Jonah who wouldn't go do what God told him to do until he got into test? And then he was swallowed by a whale. Right. And had a whale of a lot of problems and. But Jonah knew what he was supposed to do. But when he was in the belly of a whale for three days, he changed his mind. He had a new mindset.

God sent me to preach to people of Nineveh. I didn't really want to go because I don't like them people. I don't like the people of Nineveh. I know God's merciful and he's going to forgive them. I don't want them forgiven. Long short of the whole story. And he was right. God, God is merciful. God is kind. God is loving. So he wanted them to get what he thought they had coming. So he went the other way. It's funny. Who? God. Jesus. In it. And so, you know, Joe was smart enough to get a clue. He says, think I'm going to go to Denver? I think I should go to Denver. Then he called his situation nothing, nothing more than the lion vanishes. And then he went forsake the mercy that was being offered to him. Now, if you feel like a victim, then you're certainly going to act like one. That's just the way it works. You eventually talk like a victim. Develop the mentality and attitude of a victim because what you feed on will grow.

But what you starve will die. I like this particular if you want to call it a sermon, because it was one I was. I couldn't write fast enough. I hear. I hear and I write. I hear and I write. And Lord, he'll give you things that you know. But he also say, I don't want to talk about that part, what, you know. And so I was writing this down. Is there a connection between how I feel and what I do? Think about it. Is there a connection about how I feel about things and then what I go do about then when I go do after that? In other words, you may feel depressed. You may feel like the words not working. You may feel lonely, hopeless, you may feel afraid. But if you allow yourself to be governed by those emotions, negative emotions, then defeat and destruction for you are probably inevitable. You may say, Yeah, I feel those feelings right now. But second Corinthians five seven says We walk by faith and not by senses. Now, listen to this. This is just me writing down. Feelings are the enemy of faith because they contradict the word. We all have feelings, right? It feels good to feel good. But what if you don't feel good? What if you're going through a mental attack or a mental stress? What if you have problems on every side and those feelings always suggest something to you? In other words, they're not just feelings.

I was talking about the line. The mentality, the line. He's not the biggest. He's not the strongest. He's not the smartest. But he's the king. Why is he the king? I mean, can you see a giraffe looking down in the and and then the lion. He's got a big robe. He looked up at giraffe and he says, I am your king. The giraffe could just punt, kick him. All the hippo had to do just roll over on him. But the lion thinks these people are his lunch. Because he has a different mentality. What's your mentality? What's your mentality? What's your attitude? You can't make important decisions based on how you feel. Don't ever make important decisions when your feelings and your emotions are out of sync. Most of the time you'll misinterpret. Feelings didn't go to the cross for you. Feelings didn't bleed and die for you. Feelings wasn't your sacrifice for sins. So feelings can't rule as your savior. Your feelings will never bring victory to you because the walk of sight is the walk of the flesh. When you go back and read Romans eight, 14 and 16, we find out that he says he says we are sons of God and sons of God are led by the spirit of God.

Your weapons is the word of God, which he has no defense for. So he's never going to fight a war with you based on your terms. He's going to draw you away from everything. He's going to draw you into the realm of the senses. And it says, what are you going to do? I mean, and he's not introducing himself here. I'm here to fight you on the devil. He'll see my pitchfork and here's my ID He'd rather you think that he does not even exist, you know.

You know you can have. What was it? The Underwood ham years ago, you know, had him with the, you know, red suit, the pitchfork and had the long tail. He's never going to come that way. You'll never step out and do anything that that involves the anointed. If your activity is based on how you feel and how you feel, whether you're annoyed or not, then you'll do nothing. You'll have. What are you going to do when they get out of check? What are you going to do when fear comes? Because fear comes to everybody about something and your feelings are real in the sense of you feel them and they're there, but it doesn't mean that they're true. So how do you do? Well, you have to bring them into a system of checks and balances. You have to you have to take every thought the Bible says, and you have to determine whether that thought or that feeling is truth based on this book, not based on how you feel.

If there's a spirit and there is that's over the South, the Bible Belt. It is. It is the it is the spirit of religion. And its biggest message is the sovereignty of God. It means in opposition to which when we're preaching, you know, a few weeks ago about stop opposing yourself, that's where this this verse was one of the verses we use. The carnal mind. Your parents might have been great people. But when you're when your mind is not renewed to the Word of God, your mind is an enemy, is an opposition. It's hostile to God. It cannot agree with God. Amen. Won't. Won't. Jesus was asked by his disciples, Well, would you teach us how to pray? Because your life looks pretty good. I mean, signs, wonders, miracles. I mean, what should we pray? Our Father, which art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth. The way it's been done there. Oh, God wants what's being done there to be done here? How does he do that? He wants to use you. Amen. But how does he get his will done with a mind that opposes him? I know. I get right to the point sometimes. You need to learn to esteem your emotions and esteem the Word of God. Amen. When you're governed by your emotions, the devil has an entryway because you're not resisting. James four seven. In faith. So you make yourself accessible to him when you don't resist the enemy.

When you don't have control over your mouth and your mind, your words are just going to say, Oh, it's killing me.

I already knew what I knew. But the year of Covid was our greatest year to that point until the next year. And it was better than that. The next year is better than that with the least amount of people. We have. I don't know, my accountant says. He says, Well, you know, they try to keep it with things.

But they're just givers to the ministry. You know what I do with it? I do what you do with it. I pay bills. I send people to the mission field. We're helping starting the school in Liberia because they don't have they don't have any they don't have any school. The kids aren't going to school. They can't afford school. There is no school. So me and some other pastors from Michigan and this pastor's wife, she used to be an educator and had Christian school. They actually retired from pastor. And she said, well, we don't have the funds are not allocated. In other words, she went out to pastor anymore. So we don't have any say so about whatever. But the pastor wants to help some, she says. But his his needs are much greater than that, she says.

So all my friends, you know, she said, they're all retired, living on social Security, but they're all going to take so much of their Social Security to get these kids through school. And I said, Well, that's amazing. That's generous. She said, Yeah, they're all Social Security. And she said, But we had Christian school for years. And and so these kids don't know how to read. They don't know how to write. There's no school for them. The the government is corrupt, but we have five teachers who's going to teach start off with 50 kids. But the teachers in Liberia now, they have they have a degree in teaching and some have a college degree as a teacher. So they have to be paid. So the teacher, you know, says she has to have \$30 a week. So they're paying for three. If I'll pay for two, so I can put 5050 kids in school this year if I just have \$2,400. You want to know what I do with that money? The people who don't know show up. We're sponsoring kids who don't have a chance to go to school. Five, six, eight. I mean, they're going to have kids that are 12 years old who don't even know the alphabet. But in two weeks, they're going to be going to school because you sent them there. Now, is that important? I just told it because I think you ought to know some of the things that happens.

How about that? Is it important? I mean, what future will they have if they can't read, write, spell or do math or do anything? Right now, the goal is just go from kindergarten to third grade, you know, using the church that you already built. One day there might be a facility. That'd be great. One day you might have all the books. But it's like I told the pastor yesterday, Pastor Sondergard says faith makes plans. Vice makes plans. So we'll start here. We'll start here. So all the things that come together when the government, whatever, and for it to be legal and everyone and we got four teachers said we're coming, but we we have to have \$120 a month to live on. There's some of the highest paid people. So most people in his church and Sondergaard's church works all week and they make \$12. So he so they bring \$1.20. His total income for the church. Right now, he takes in anywhere from 100 to \$150. He has over 100 people. And then they look at your life and think they could think that that ain't fair. It just don't it ain't fair. So you have to teach them, because there's only one Bible for the world. I know it looks different than it does here, but there's a way to. If Joseph can prosper in prison and God say you're prosperous, you know, when you don't own yourself and God says you're prosperous.

God doesn't think like you think. Amen. I mean, when you're when you're a slave and you don't own you, that's that's seems to me poor. But God said he's prosperous. And he was a success. And it was because even for his slave owner, he saw that God was doing things in him and he put him in charge of the entire prison. They went from the prison to the palace. They'd become the vice president of the nation. With a felony. Yeah. Well, if you get a felony, your life is over. Joseph, don't even know what you're talking about. Well, what do you do? He had a dream. Talked about it. Yeah. You know, he had the. The baker and the undertaker. You didn't go too well for some of them. Okay. Oh, gosh. That lion clock in Jesus name I rebuke you in Jesus name. Stop that. This is kind of some things unusual that don't usually come out of me. I won't get to all this. So the thing is, and we'll get there next time. He wants us to learn how to trust him. He wants to go from trying to trusting. This is a little funny thing. Yesterday I thought about and I believe I just heard it this way, he says, you know, when people die, he says, he says most people talk about and they'll put it on their on their on their tombstone and say, rest in peace.

Whatever you ever felt like your life wasn't working, be honest with you. Like it was a big, chaotic mess. Like, what are we actually doing? I mean, are we making any difference at all? It's like, where are we headed? It's like I used to like you. I've even heard this. I'll admit this because y'all was kidding about that day. If you'd have done this when we was dating, you know, we probably would never be married. I was like, Well, I didn't feel like I need to ever do it till I met you. We went to Paris, Georgia, and Miss Phyllis's house a couple of Fridays ago. And, you know, he was just real quiet. Then he asked me a couple of things and I told him I was telling him some stories and I wasn't trying to, but they just all laughing and all these pastors in the room. And he said on the way he says, Eric, I don't remember. When did you get to be so funny? I said, Well, I didn't mean I don't think I was like this growing up. I said, I said, Be honest with you. I said, I think it started when I started pastoring.

I didn't want to buy it. I didn't want to buy that building. I said, I don't buy no funeral home. He said, Well, then do what you want to. I said, Oh, I fixed buy me a funeral home. I knew I was that smart. Gave me the prize. The price was 100 and. \$65,000. I gave 165,000 less what they asked for. They just laughed him off. In the third time. You know, my realtor, she was embarrassed to make the offer again, which I would have been, too. But it's a friend of mine, so I just said, Well, I woke up one morning about a week later. It looked like nothing work and the Holy Spirit just said, he says, Well, you ready to close on that building today? Buy the building? I said. Really? He said. Oh. Just. How'd that go? What's the question? Do you want.

So that a week later, when the Holy Spirit I woke up, he says, Are you ready to close on the building? I says, That building? He says, I only talked to you about one. I said, That's right. I said, okay. He said, okay, now call your realtor and say this and say it exactly like this and tell her to present this offer to them. Use these words right here. Don't. Don't change the words. Say it just like this. And I said, Well, how much will I offer? He said, 210. I was like, Boy, my realtor, she's like, Eric, you just. But I said, Well, I'm sorry, it's embarrassing to you. I said, But but we're going to buy the building and this is the offer. I said, Just be honest with what the Lord told me. She says, Yeah, I know, but you know, you're buying 8000 square.

And two hours later they called back and they said she said because she'd already told me, she said, well, she's a friend of mine and I had the floor covering store.

So so I became at least a better risk than who was in there because they wouldn't get paid. Then I guess the Lord knew that.

He said, We're going to make the loan, but you'll have to have a well, I have to have a year, you know, he said. He says, we don't make loan less than two years, he says. And now that, you know, he says this, this is almost in foreclosure. So that's the reason why we're willing to take the risk, he said. But we have to have a year. And I said, Well, I'm only about four months away from that and account. I need another month to pull the thing together. I said, I'll have it in six months. So it was a year. You know, two. We'll pay you so much a month. Then in a year or less, we'll pay it off. So when I call back and I presented that to him, he, he, he he cost me like a dog. He says he come out there and said, You you stole this place. You absolutely stole this place. I said, No, I didn't.

I said, 15 families I ain't even seen. I didn't want to tell him, You can have 15 people at one time. He's got 15 families all signed, 5 or \$10,000. He wanted to spread it around. So if something goes wrong to get the building. But they got more security, I said, No, I can't do that. I said it would be me or nothing. He said, Well, we wouldn't want you to sign the whole.

I'm renting a building for \$400 a month using all my faith, I think, to pay \$400 rent. I just went full time and I'm buying a quarter million dollar building. So I called Michelle back and I said, I need to know right now how much we got in the church that's free.

It's \$100. \$100. We own a building, but we have \$100. Because faith makes plans. And if I went by my senses, we never would have bought that building. But I had a word from God, and the plans of man will always fail you. But the word of God will never fail you.
