Well, good morning and welcome to Gracelife Church. Glad that each one is here. Want to say happy Father's Day to everyone here this morning. Thank God for spiritual men. Amen. And I don't know how we was all raised different ways and fathers and we all love and care for our fathers. Some of them may have different experiences, better, maybe some not as good as others, I don't know. But ultimately, what we're really doing is we want to think of ABBA Father. Our our father. Father, You know, your father was a was a young man and he was a boy and he was a child. And someone said, It's a boy. And so they aren't perfect by any stretch of the imagination. But God didn't call us to be fathers or mothers because we're perfect. But he gave us a book right here and he gave us his Holy Spirit. And and with that information, we can be exactly who we are called to be. We can be the leaders. We're called to be men and women. And so I just want to thank God and thank you for the the men that are here this morning and in this church that have made this ministry strong, really, really strong. Before we came on the air, late was receiving the offer. And he talked about things that we've done to we've been able to do to hear abroad in the community and and missions for the last three years.

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Actually four years. We just increased every year in what we're doing in the community. But we're doing it into the world. We are broadcasting. We started this a number of years ago, but kind of got more serious about it in the last few years. I kind of be honest. We had to be pushed into it just a little bit. But I had a good a good and kind pusher. And so we're we're we're ministering several different ways. You may be watching by Facebook or you can certainly view on YouTube. We're live there both times simultaneously. And then we go into an audio broadcast and then that the audio of this morning will go and it will be dispersed by different ways and means and it'll go into over 40 countries. We have an active listening audience every every time the mic is turned on around the world, we have an active listening audience of over 1100 people. And so we thank God for the ability to, in the privilege that we have to to preach the gospel, the policy, the great ineffectual door has been opened unto me. I thank him for that verse doesn't end there. The last part of that verse is and when the door is open, you'll find that there's many adversaries. So we don't always want to quote the whole verse, but there's an opportunity. But, but when there's an opportunity, there's always an enemy. But that's okay, because that's what we're doing.

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We are equipping ourselves with the Word of God. We have the tools in front of us and we have with within us to effectively do the work that we're called to do and be fruitful in it. This is a good, according to my opinion, whatever that means. This is a good place for us to really dig in. I'm trying to I'm trying to say this is a great time to listen. If you've been listening, Amen here and going forward, I don't generally come with notebooks like this. I came Friday with a notebook like this, and I came up here just to to to actually pray. And I don't ever pray. I don't go anywhere and pray without something to write with and without this. So if you don't have something to write with and you're not expecting God to say nothing to you. Of course you can write in your phone and all that kind of stuff if you know how to do that and like to do it that way, you can certainly do that. But but here's the deal. So I was up here and I wrote, I don't know, I had no intentions of writing anything unless you said anything. And and it came into ten pages. For those of you who wasn't here last week, we're in the series. Stop opposing yourself, Kid named a lot of things, you know, stop opposing your your miracle. Stop opposing your your financial blessings.

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Stop opposing yourself and healing or whatever, whatever the situation might be. Just make it work for whatever is working on in your life. But if you hadn't watched it go back to the broadcast also and I mentioned this, but I just want to remind you, if you go if you go to the website, you'll be a place there where you can see there's a transcript of, you know, in written form of everything said. Now, it's not exactly 100% accurate. Probably if I would speak better English more plainly, you could pick up the words better. So sometimes it's like, huh, But it misses so few words, so you can actually go read it. Or if you wanted to, you can print it off and and if you want to keep it in your files, if you have a file. So with all that to work with, I don't know how to help you anymore. Tell them. Show them they can listen, They can watch. They can pull it off. They can get they can transcribe it. Because sometimes I remember going to Bible school. I wasn't that great a note taker when Michelle and I was at Rhema. Michelle was is a great note taker. So I. I listened really well. You know, when you move, when you move seven, 800 miles to do something you thought you would never do and you're there. I didn't always pay attention to school. I wasn't that great a student because I wasn't that interested.

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I wished I had been and I should have been, but I wasn't. But at this stage of my life, I was 30 years old. And it Raymond, I was paying lots of attention. And so Michelle would take notes and and sometimes they'd help you say, like, you might want to write that down because you might see it again on a test. That means it will be on the test. So they would even help you with that. But I would write things down and my mind was focused on what I was writing, so I can't really hear what he's saying past it. Somehow Michelle was doing like dictation. I don't know how she does it. So if I had to, I'd just go back and get her notes, see what I missed. But. But I listened really well. I listened well enough to come out Raymond with a 3.9.7 GPA from listening. But that doesn't mean you remember it. So it's good to have things written down. I suppose God knew that. Anyway, he Aren't you glad he gave us a written copy? 40 authors. And if you want to know what these people and other people have went through to get us this Bible, just read if you can stomach it, the Foxe's Book of Martyrs and you'll see the people who gave their life and the way they were tortured and the way they died. It's not a it's not a fun read, but you'll have an appreciation for this word when you find out what they, you know, when they were actually skinned alive.

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Their flesh removed from their body and then poured salt all in them. Don't make another copy of this or it'll happen to you. But that didn't stop them. So I hope we have that appreciation for it. So. So I'm going to go rather quick today or not. And we're going to we're going to go back to our our main text and second Timothy chapter two. And I'm going to pick up in verse 24, and it says this Paul is writing to Timothy a letter. And Timothy is what, Paul's son in the spirit, his spiritual son, Timothy Young. Timothy apparently is getting some yannina from the from the church, from the congregation. Does that happen in church? Oh, yeah, it happens. It doesn't happen here. I can remember when it did happen. I had some good advice when I started the church. Someone with a church, over a thousand people. I said, What do I need to do to be an effective pastor? He said, You'll have to be tougher than hell. For one thing, those words became very, very true. It seemed like I heard John Osteen say this same thing when he built Joel's dad, John, when he built the church Lakewood. He said the first two years, it seemed like Satan sent everybody that he could across the planet to try to kill us before we could get going.

And then I think those same people came to Alabama. But we were talking about some of these stories the other day, and I was like and I was going back 30 years ago and thinking, you know, what happened? I was like, wow, didn't that did all happened in the first 2 or 3 years? I mean, we met more nuts, more just crazy people that you could not help. I mean, there's a preacher service sermon years ago. There's 12 kinds of people that you can't help today. Don't mean they can never be helped, but in their frame of mind, you, you can't help them. Today Jesus met people that he couldn't help and walked away from them. You're not going to help everybody and you're not called to help everybody. Amen. Amen. And when you figure that out quicker, sooner than later, your life will go a whole lot easier and you won't be frustrated. But anyway, so Paul said, and the servant Lord must not strive, but be gentle to all men apt to teach and be patient. Serving the Lord must not do what? Strive, but be gentle to all men apt to teach and be patient. Well, I read that. I thought, well, it calls me out of ever being the ministry. Well, turns out everything that you need from the fruit of the spirit. Patience is one of those fruit.

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So you have it. But you have to employ it. Then he says, in meekness, instructing those that what? Are being opposed. No, they weren't, y'all. Can y'all talk? Where are you at? Verse 25. Second. Timothy 225. In meekness, doing what? Instructing those that what oppose themselves. They oppose themselves. If God prevents you will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth. Verse 26. That they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil who are taken captive by him at his will. So notice this is this is basically a one man show. Uh, you have no one to blame for this. And that's one of the classifications of people that you can't help. Is that someone where everything is somebody else's fault? Yeah, They don't take responsibility for themselves. In other words, where they are in life is somebody else's fault or it's your fault if someone blames you for where they are in life. It's hard. It's hard for you to help that person. Uh, everybody in here. We all have a story and some. And it's a winding road. And there's some things that just. Some of them curves were dangerous. Some of those you supposed to slow down if you went around it. Some of you didn't actually make the curve to to to to to to to to. There were some bumps in the road. There were some people that the enemy sent your way and your path not just to block you, but to stop you and actually to destroy you if you can.

But you're not put here for destruction. You're sitting here to destroy. That's right. Amen. Can I talk to you that plain? The scripture said that for the Jesus came for this purpose. To destroy. Destroy the works of the devil. Destroy them. Well, we're called to do what Jesus calls so, so, so, so we're here to blow up, huh? We're not here to hinder. We're here to. To blow up. Yeah. So when we hear doctrine, that's not true. And the only way that you can know what is true is know the truth. Amen. There is a feel good doctrine. There are many feel good churches. They're real popular to keep a lot of congregation. They have to have a lot of programs and they have to have a lot of feel good stuff. Makes me feel good. There's a lot of feel good songs. You would think there's a whole lot of songs that you can sing today that scriptural. There's very few of them. I mean, there's songs that we still sing today and we'll, you know, Chris and I talk about it. She says, Well, it says this. I said, I know. I said, I said I was going to write songs too now. And some of them are just beautiful, you know, And so but they're just not scriptural. But they do. They do. They're applicable to people because they they make them feel good in their emotions.

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So what we're going to do, he said, You're opposing yourself. In other words, God has a plan and the enemy's God's for you and the enemy's against you. It's just that simple. John. Ten. Ten. Right. John ten. Ten is the dividing line of the Bible, the. And New Covenant. He just said, Satan come to kill, steal and destroy. But I didn't come to do that. I came to give life and give it to you more abundantly. Amen. And so we divide it by that. So how do we oppose ourselves? Well, as we get further, we're going to talk about there's actually three men that we we have to know something about. When I say men, I'm talking about men and women. I'm talking about believers. So but there's three in the word. There's there's three men or three mindsets that we have to understand and know what they are. One is we haven't covered this, but we'll get into it. One is the natural man, one is the carnal man, and the other one is the spiritual man. The natural man is the man who's he's not born again. He's unsaved. He can't he can't understand nothing about the things of God. The Bible says. He says he can't discern anything. To him, everything looks crazy. It looks foolish. You can talk spiritual matters to someone spiritually dead. And they're like, What? Because they're spiritually dead? Well, we were spiritually dead when we.

When we. When we were born again. Right? I mean, when we came into the earth. God, just have a seat anywhere you like. There's coffee and water out there if you want some. Somebody ate all the donuts. I wouldn't. I wasn't kind. But anyway, so we're in. We're in a series called Stop Opposing Yourself. Stop opposing yourself. And that's how it came to me. Stop opposing yourself. Well, so we there's a contrast that we're talking about. The natural man the Bible calls the natural man. He's just someone who's not saved. He's never been born again. He's been born one time by a natural birth, but he's not born again. Remember what Jesus told Nicodemus? Nicodemus couldn't understand it. Here he is, you know. You know, he's. He's big in the religious world. You know, the rabbi, the teacher and Jesus kind of, you know, he lovingly said, You don't know much, do you? So he said, Nicodemus said, How will a man like me, me, be born again? I mean, my parents are not even here. How am I going to re-enter my mother's womb? So Jesus, like, oh boy, three and a half years. So no, he said, you know, you have to be born of the water and of the spirit. So the natural man is just someone who's not born again. He's unsaved, the carnal man. Now you understand, the carnal man quite often is someone who's born again.

They're saved, but they're saved. They're born again. So in their spirit, in your spirit, the moment you get saved, the millisecond you get saved. Christ came into you, into your spirit in Ephesians said after you got saved, he sealed your spirit. Amen. Now, those of us who are old enough remember when Granny can things put them in jars? And then, you know, later that year she'd go make cold and she'd go make a pan of cornbread. Come on, somebody. And then and get out the vegetable soup. And she went and got one of them old jars. How many how many of y'all know what I'm talking about? No one. No. Young. You know what I'm talking about. But when you got the jar, a mason jar and you open the lid, what did it have on top? It had a little. Had a little round disk. A little seal. Right. And how do you know if it did its job? It goes. What? It goes. If it doesn't. If it doesn't do that, give it to your brother in law or somebody else. Say, here, take this home now. Could you take that off the tape? Okay. That wasn't love, was it? But that's what that's why we know it was sealed. It was preserved. The Book of Jude, which is only one page, he says, at the end. This thing, when you get to heaven, the father is going to Jesus. The son is going to take you to the Father.

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So what changed instantly was that you became a new creation in Christ. What? Second Corinthians 517 Once translation said a new species of being that has never existed. In other words, God came to live on the inside. You are now the Temple of God. Your spirit is God's address. You get that? You are a mobile throne, not not a mobile home. You're a mobile throne wherever you go. You have the throne of God on the inside of you. Ephesians says you've been seated with God in heavenly places. If you're a student of those things where you look up the word seated, it means enthroned. You are in the throne with Christ. You are now doing what Christ did while He was on the earth. Christ actually occupied two different worlds at one time. He told you, John, 17. You're not even of this world. Amen. Jesus said he wasn't of this world. And John, 17 the night before he was crucified. He prayed this. He said, Father, keep them. He said, They're not of this world, just like I'm not of this world. So you're in heaven positionally seated with Christ ruling and reigning far above all principality and power and might and dominion at the same time you're dealing with with with the things in this natural world. I found for me, for me, the best day, the best way to deal with the news for me is don't hear it. I wasn't confused who I was before I heard it.

I'm not confused after. There's so much confused about identity now. Well, there doesn't have to be confusion. See. Could we just say God's right? But see, people's feelings are real to them. You know, the enemy can work in the area of feelings. The thing is why we don't look at it that way is because the devil don't come to you like that. Underwood. Ham. He doesn't have a red suit and a pitchfork and a long tail. So I'm the devil coming out of you, boy. So you don't see him that way? So you don't get out your, you know, your 36 and blow his head off. But you have weapons. Second Corinthians says that are not carnal, but they're mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds. Jesus showed us how a man, a man Jesus had to come as a man. He was God and he was man. But he was. He's man. The Bible says he will always know, be known in heaven as the son of man. Can you imagine agreeing to be going from God? To being born a human on this earth, being full deity to be so He's your example of how we are here. Flesh in flesh. And he came as a man filled with the Holy Ghost and walked in total authority, love, dominion and everything as a man. Feel the Holy Ghost. So if you're born again and you're filled with the Holy Ghost, you have everything Jesus had.

Amen. You have to. I mean, it'd be wrong. It'd be unkind, unkind for Jesus to tell us. Before he left. He said, The works that I do will you do? And greater works than these. Because I go to my father. If you didn't give us the same stuff to work with. I mean, if you go tell me to build a house and take away all the tools, I'm not going to build much even if I know how to do it. Now, that's an example. Ain't no one gonna ask me to build anything. But anyway, so we want to look at this as we go forward. We want to look at this natural man. We want to look at the man who's governed by the flesh. And we want to look at man who's governed by the spirit. What we're turning what we want to do is we want to do what Ephesians four said, which is that we come to the fullness of who we are in Christ. Paul didn't say, Come to come to me. He didn't. Paul never pointed to himself. He did say, Follow me as I follow Christ. But there's a couple of times I can find what Paul got off. I ain't following him that day. I'm not criticizing you at all, but we can follow Christ. He's our example and everything. So, like, I had no idea when I came up here Thursday or Friday, I had no idea I was going to write this right here.

I was just kind of praying about the service from last week and why we're doing that. This won't mean as much to you as it to me as it will mean to me, because this is this is number five in the series. And so it would mean more to me someone who prayed it out and studied it out, wrote it out and preached it. So Monday, for those of you who were here last week and heard the service so Monday, Kristin, wave him. That's Kristin. She's my youngest daughter. And Amy raised her her her older sister. Yeah, Older sisters always tell you what to do. You don't have to be right. But they can still tell you. I know something about that. Don't raise your hand now. Yeah. I have forgiven her, though. If you think I have large cheekbones cheeks because she pulled them out for years. And one day my brother and I figured out we could take her together, and that ended that forever. Did you turn out? You see how good I turned out? Yeah. Amen. So after the now. Now, last Sunday, Christian was teaching Children's church. So she wasn't in here, so she didn't see her hearing the service. So Monday, she's washing dishes at home, and she prophetically gets these things and stops washing dishes. And apparently the Lord knows where Jemison is and knows where their house is and just tired of washing dishes and doing nothing spiritual except when your spirit everything spiritual.

I said, So you've already watched the service from yesterday? She said, No, I hadn't watched the service. And I said, Well, go watch the service, not because I'm interested, but just like you weren't even in the service and the Lord talked to you about this washing dishes. Well, if I was going to write, you know, like a bullet points for last Sunday, it would have been this. It says this because it's finished. Because it's finished. That's the reason why. But you may say, Lord, help me for my senses lie. They do lie. That's why I said, don't be ruled by what you see, for what you see is seldom reality. Walking by the senses makes things complicated. Walking by the senses will only leave you exasperated if you walk in by what you see. You're not walking in what is done. If you're walking in, what is done, you're not walking in what is done, you're not walking as a son.

If you're the performer instead of the believer, you're not in rest and you won't be a receiver by grace through faith. That's always going to be the instruction. The more you add to that, you'll walk in self destruction. My yoke is easy and my burden is light. Don't gauge your deliverance by the intensity of the fight. The washing dishes. That's called walking in the flesh. You'll lose every time. But if you come up in the spirit, you'll see you can cease from your climb. I don't say climb the mountain. I said move it and your senses will say, This mountain ain't moved. Prove it. So you'll keep trying to move the mountain with the sweat of your brow. You read 50 books on man's interpretation of how you work and you work. It'll be to no avail, because the mountain you're trying to move has already fell. And at that very instant, it ceased from living. So I tell you now it's finished. It is done. Rest, rest, rest. In my son. Even if there is still green on the leaf, don't be fooled into unbelief. Walk in the spirit and you'll see the fig tree is surely there. Because I love you. And I never go back on what I said. I mean, she could just come give that. I could have stayed home. Okay. So let me let me get back to my notes. So here it is, the life of the new man in Christ.

How many are in Christ? The life of the new man in Christ was never meant to be governed by your senses. Which is your mind and your body. When the Bible says Romans eight six, it talks about. It talks about the carnal man is enmity against God. The word image doesn't mean the enemy. It means opposition. So when you're in your carnal mind, that means you're gauging everything through your senses. And we have five senses. And thank God that we have them. Because, I mean, this will sound like we're against the senses, but how many of y'all like a good steak? Amen. Anybody like seafood? Anybody like pizza? How many glad that you have senses when you eat pizza. How many y'all like sweets? How many? Glad you got good taste buds when you're eating sweets. Come on, somebody. So. But you know, if you didn't have senses and you got hold of some milk and it wasn't good, and you and you couldn't smell it and you couldn't taste it, your nose may not work. Your taste buds. Not my work. But when you put that spoiled milk down, your. Your stomach will work and up she'll come. But what Paul is saying is he says you're born again in the spirit. Everything in you is sealed and just right. It's just like God. But now you're going to have to renew your mind, your soul to what is already true in your spirit.

See in your spirit, since you've been born again, your spirit has never touched sin. I didn't say you haven't never seen. I'm saying the real you hasn't. Because sin can't touch it. So you got to hear this the way I'm trying to say it and don't make it something. I'm not making a doctrine or something crazy. Since you've been born again, the real you that sealed the real you, that one day will leave here and leave the whole body and everything behind. The real you has never missed it. Because God missed it. Well, then you ain't missed it in your spirit. I didn't say in your soul. In your body. The body is just neutral. Right. It'll just do. I mean, it's just like if I had a puppet here and I, you know, and I just laid it down, it'd just be there. Just be material. But if I slip my hand in it, then it would have motion and it would have to do. I mean, just like when you put your clothes on, you took them off the rack. You were just sitting there on a hanger where it was sitting. It wasn't doing nothing, but it didn't take shape until you put your arm in it, until you put your legs in the pants or dress or whatever you did. And then it began to take shape. So your soul's that way that it's just it's been programmed by the world when you when you got born again.

Now it has to be reprogrammed because you have a pattern, a way of doing things where you've always done them. So Romans 1212 says, don't be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. So you have to you have to renew. You have to renovate your mind. We ain't always been right. So the word repent really just means change your mind. Just change your mind. Well, if you've been doing something for 20 years and not getting results just because everybody did, you. We need to find out what God said. It may go against everything you've ever known, believed, believed to be true, but, you know, the scripture says God is not a man, that he should lie. And he's never, never has reason to repent. He don't have to change his mind because he's right. Now, I want to get real plain, if I can, because I want this to help us. So the life of the new man was never meant to be governed by his senses. You the real man. We have a spirit. We are a spirit. Right. First Thessalonians says we. We are a spirit, not we have one.

We are a spirit. We have a soul. And we live in a body. Okay, now, so the life of the new man in Christ was never meant to be governed by their mind or their body. Your spirit man is the executive administrator, conductor and manager of your soul and body. See. Man is the three part being spirit, soul and body. Your spirit's just is made just like God. Remember? I mean, Genesis one, you have the Trinity here. And they said, Let us, us being more than one, the 3 in 1. Let us make man in our image and in our likeness. And they said, okay. And let's also put into him dominion. I didn't make that up. I mean, it's in Genesis one. Let us make man in our image and in our likeness. And Genesis two, he makes the body. But the body is lifeless. He makes. He makes Adam, and Adam's has no life in him. But then he breathed into his nostrils, God's God's breathed into to his nostrils. And he said he became a living spirit. The actual Hebrew says he became a speaking spirit. You know, it puts you above everything in the planet just like God, because you can speak. Now animals can speak. They have a language, but they can't speak. I don't care how human you think they are. I mean, I get up some days, I'll come home from church and Michelle has a dog.

And well, we four years into it and she takes that dog with her low sometimes or even Walmart and people think she needs a rescue dog. Actually she's there to rescue the dog because if you leave that dog with me, it's miserable for everybody. I mean, I don't know what someone did to that thing, but she they must have really got to her because her whole world wrapped around Michelle and she likes Christian Elliott. And I'm not necessarily a dog person. I mean, I had tons of dogs, but, you know, they had hair. And my folks said, that means the hair is for him to hang on outside. So so I'll get home from church sometimes or I'll wake up and go in the living room and that dog sitting in my chair and she's taking my blanket with her teeth and pulled it over her. Or I mean, she's so Michelle sits in a recliner this way and the couch is, you know, right there or the couch is right here. Michelle sitting right there on the and and she has a blanket to sit on and she wants to be covered up. So she'll jump up on the couch and she'll look at her and like it's like, get I want my blanket. Well, she's speaking. She has body language, but she can't say, would you cover me up with a blanket? That's that's the difference.

That's one of the major difference. Because you're a spirit. You're speaking spirit. How did how did God create the planet speaking? And, you know, Genesis one said and God said and God said and God said and God said. Let there be. Let there be. Let there be let there be let there be light. You know the heavens, the firmament. Da da da da. The land, the trees. God said. And then it said. And it was. So what was so what God said. He said, look, he said they have to have that in them because we're going to give them dominion. So they have to be a speaking spirit. So what they say will be so. That means you're having what you've been saying, good or bad. You've been having what you've been saying. So if you don't change what you're believing, then you'll not change what you're speaking. Which means you're going to keep on having what you're saying because you are speaking spirit and he put dominion in you. So you're going to you're going to get to have what you keep on saying. Yeah. Now confessing the word I know is, is something that's been taught that some people are like, yeah, and you can drive anything into a ditch. But confessing, confessing the word or speaking the word is simply you.

The word confess just means to say the same thing, to agree and say the same thing. So if I need healing in my body is sick and needs healing, I got to go find out what God said about it and what he did about it. And then I begin to speak what he said. My speaking don't make it so. Because it's already so my speaking puts me in agreement with the Covenant and now it makes it so for me. Amen. So you're not creating healing because there's already a healer. You're just agreeing with what he said, which makes it so that's all that you're doing. Okay. Moving on a little bit faster. So and in second Corinthians ten, five says, We can demolish what we, the spirit man, can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture. This is the passion translation. We capture like prisoners of war. Every thought or scheme. And insist that it bow in obedience to the anointed one. So we see that we we the spirit man we can we demolish every. Deceptive thought that. There's that word oppose again that our text in second Corinthians two where it said Paul told Timothy the ministry of the word to them teach them because he says what they're doing. And he said, these people are opposing themselves. He says teach them the truth that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who the devil has taken them captive by his own will.

In other words, they become easy prey for him. So when you're when you understand who you are in the spirit, then you'll have you'll have an opportunity to walk by the spirit or walk by the truth or to walk in the corner realm or carnal just means like like you order a chili Concordia, like you're saying, it just means meat. The mind. The meat. Meathead. We jokingly call someone meat here. We'll not call you meat here. But I'm just saying. But. But you're walking according to your physical senses. And so all the everything that, you know, to this point of life, you've learned through all your five senses. Naturally. Yeah. I mean, I have a son that when he's three years old, every time I would grill out, he would he was fascinated somehow by the grill and he saw this vapor coming up. I said, Don't touch this. This is a burn you badly. Okay? And I tell him four or 5 or 6 times he come, I said, Don't touch the grill. I said, That'll burn. Well, I walked off and he come up and said, I don't know. You know what it did. Yeah. Bernie. And he slept by our bed for three nights and. And I put him on actually it was his bed. We, we had three kids at the time in a 14 by 17 trailer with two bedrooms.

And there was four of us in one room and one and one had a bedroom to himself because he couldn't sleep. Nobody else. And the way you could do that is we had a I had a folding beach chair. What was the three year old? No. And I put blankets and everything. And and the only problem was and then we had a baby bed. Amy was at the end of the bed, and I had to crawl off the bed to get up the middle. And I. If you had to go to the bathroom, try not to wake the baby. I couldn't go this side because my son's down there and I just put a pan of water down there and every few minutes he cried. I put his hand down that water and that. So. But I never had to tell him again. Chad, don't touch a heated grill when I cook hamburgers or something like that. And he'd see the grill go up. He'd run the other way up the side of the yard. He's terrified. Well, that was the information to him that stayed with him forever. As you walked in life, I told him saying, don't do this, don't do this, don't do this, And he he learned not to do it sometimes the hard way, like some of us. And, you know, if you pay enough fines, then you'll actually learn it.

Just like if you do this, it's going to cost you. Well, we've learned everything through our five senses. But you're not supposed to be living this life according to your senses. So we have need of our senses, but they're not supposed to govern your life. Emotions aren't supposed to govern your life. And you know this to be true. Come in. I don't know. Whatever it was, you just felt good. But did that feeling stay with you forever? And we just felt really bad, like, you know, in the world, just like, man, I just couldn't get any worse. You ever had that feeling everything was going wrong? Didn't feel good, did it? Did that did that stay there forever? So if the good feelings don't stay forever and the bad feelings don't stay forever, then then they shouldn't have that much stock in your life. So to walk in the spirit, you have to find out what the word said. And that's called Walking in the Spirit. That's called walking.

Have you ever not that you heard it audibly, but how many are on the inside of you? I think everybody here. But I'll ask how many here has ever had the thought, What am I going to do now? Amen. Let me tell you who didn't say that to you. The Holy Spirit has never said, what are we going to do now? I mean, if he doesn't know I'm going home, I'm packing it up. Just like there's no need being here. I'll give you your money back and we'll just go home and forget about the whole thing. Just like, I mean, we meet and have a good time. But if the Holy Ghost is trying to figure this out as you go along, if God's trying to like trying to steer this thing some way, like a.

So when we walked according to our senses, it gets us in those kind of troubles. So I'm not doing a good job staying with my notes, which I never do. But first Corinthians 926 and 27in the ESV translation, verse 26 says, Paul says, So I run like someone who has a goal. I fight like a boxer who's hitting something not just in the air. Verse 27, he said, It is my own body. I fight. I Paul. Fight my own body. See, I'm trying to show you spirit, soul and body. Paul said I run like someone who has a goal. I fight like a boxer who's hitting something. But he says I don't fight. Just hitting the air. The next verse says it. Paul said, It is my own body. I the real man. Paul fight to make it the body. Do what I want. The spirit man. I Paul, do this that I won't miss getting the prize myself after telling others about it. So, Paul said in the King James version 27, he says, I'm bringing my body into subjection by ruling over the mind. Paul said, The only way I can do this. He said, I the real man, the spirit man, the Christ man, the new creature. Right. The spiritual man. I have to bring this body which is not me, into subjection by ruling over my mind. Can you see opposition? See, that's what we're talking about.

Because my mind still wanted to think this and think that. When you stand in front of a person and cast the devil out and while they're hissing at you and growled at you and they ain't but £90. But it looks like they must be a bunch y'all in there. Like you can't get that many in £90. I'll never forget that girl's house turned red. And she said.

Now. This would be the scripture for today that we would talk about a strong spirit. Proverbs 1814 says The strong spirit of a man will sustain him in bodily pain or trouble, but a weak and broken spirit who can raise up a bear. The strong spirit of a man sustains that man when they're in pain or they're in trouble. But a weak and broken spirit who can raise up a bear. The message translation says, A healthy spirit conquers adversity. What does a healthy spirit will conquer? Adversity. But what can you do when the spirit is crushed? I looked up that word sustained in the Hebrew because it was in Proverbs, it says. And then I looked up in the commentary. And I would try to pronounce the Hebrew word, but it's about that long. And so so the word, the Hebrew word for sustained is and it means this. It means to keep alive. The words sustain the strong spirit of a man will sustain him. Sustain means keep alive. But more than that, it's giving physical and emotional support. Sustaining something so will not just live or survive, but it will thrive.

Amen. So if your spirit is strong, you won't just be sustained. You won't just make it through barely. But you will. You will thrive because your spirit is strong. Now, quickly. A strong spirit is what sustains us in any kind of trouble. A strong spirit is confident. It's unmovable. A strong spirit is a spirit that's been established. And it's ready for anything. Paul said, I can do all things. A strong spirit is steady, under trouble, and a strong spirit is full of joy and is full of peace. No matter what situation is, if you have a strong spirit, then you'll never you'll never give up and you'll never give in. Whether you have a fan club or not. I remember through the years I had a fan club. And it wasn't always that great when we started doing Facebook years ago. And I'm preaching on grace and the love of God and, you know, God loves people, so God's in a good mood. Well, I had different people attacking the message of grace. And so it's not like that. If you do this, God hates you. And if you don't change, if you go to church, you'll end up going to hell without ministries. They did not like me to say that God was in a good mood because they wanted to picture a God. Who was this and you weren't that, and he was out to get you to crush you. In other words, like, if God can find you, he's going to get you.

It says this or someone had an abortion or someone had a miscarriage. All these things that are in this life, in this life, and people are looking for love and they're looking for acceptance. They're looking for someone to love them perfectly. And the only person who actually loves you perfectly is the one who created you, ABBA Father. And he is for you and he's not against you. His message is of love, not hate. He's not a divider. The Pharisees hated Jesus because he ate with sinners. Jesus didn't go away.
