- 7. Withdrawal: This is a strategy of the devil to isolate believers from the spiritual support of their family, their church and their community. 1Kgs.19; Jonah: Jon.4:5-11
- 8. Rebellion: Satan projects rebellious thoughts into your mind. Isa.14:12-14;
- 9. Improper Motives. Satan attacks the minds of believers by subtly introducing improper motives to corrupt their desire to serve and then elevate those motives to mock their Christian service.

- 10. Wrong Attitudes and Emotions. Satan also manipulates the minds of believers to develop wrong attitudes and emotions that become negative strongholds for the perpetuation of evil or oppression.
- 11. Accusations and condemnations. He sends fiery darts of accusation into your mind, makes you feel inferior, and condemns you. He will give you guilty feelings of shame, unworthiness, and embarrassment. That is why he is called the accuser of the brethren. Rev.12:10; Rom.8:1
- 12. Sexual Impurity. Satan pollutes the minds of believers with projected thoughts of sexual immorality and impurity that frustrate their faith and incapacitate them in spiritual warfare.

- 13. Confusion. Satan also causes indecision, confusion, and frustration in your mind. When you are confused, indecisive, and frustrated, you obviously cannot be a good Christian soldier. 1Cor.14:33
- 14. Tormenting thoughts. There is a whole category of tormenting thoughts Satan sends into your mind including worry, anxiety, dread, apprehension, fear and nervousness. 2Tim.1:7
- 15. Compromise. Satan manipulates believers to compromise their position.
- 16. Distractions or wrong mental focus. Getting you to focus on the things that really do not matter. The things that have no eternal or spiritual relevance. Lk.12:15; 21:34; 1Jn.2:15; 1Tim.6:10; Matt.6:33

- 1. Let the Holy Spirit Search your mind frequently.
 - a. Ask the Holy Spirit to search your mind frequently and reveal unto you wrong attitudes, motives and thinking planted by the enemy. Ps.139:23-24
