DANIEL 10:1-4 NKJV

In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. DANIEL 10:5-8 NKJV

5 I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, a certain man clothed in linen, whose waist was girded with gold of Uphaz! 6 His body was like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like torches of fire, his arms and feet like burnished bronze in color, and the sound of his words like the voice of a multitude. 7 And I, Daniel, alone saw the vision, for the men who were with me did not see the vision; but a great terror fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves. 8 Therefore I was left alone when I saw this great vision, and no strength remained in me; for my [d]vigor was turned to [e]frailty in me, and I retained no strength

- 3. Stand on the word of God: Do not waver. Hold your position of faith. Do not give up. Keep your eye on the vision, on the promise and not on the delay. Heb.12:1-2; Eph.6:12-13; Romans 4:20;
- 4. Praise: When Paul and Silas prayed and nothing seem to be happening, they engaged the forces of praise and there was an earthquake that brought them out of that Philippian jail. Because praise is an invitation that God cannot refuse.

HEBREWS 12:1-2 NKJV

Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, 2 looking unto Jesus, the [a]author and [b]finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

- 5. Sacrifice.
 - a. Hannah made a vow which was a sacrifice and that broke the spell of delay.
 1Sam.1:1-20;
 - b. The dream like turnaround of Psalm 126 is a function of Sacrifice. Ps.126:1, 5-6;

1 When the Lord brought back [a]the captivity of Zion, We were like those who dream.

5 Those who sow in tears Shall reap in joy. 6 He who continually goes [c]forth weeping, Bearing [d]seed for sowing, Shall doubtless come again [e]with rejoicing, Bringing his sheaves with him.
