

Why Add Fasting to Prayer

5. Fasting helps us to develop self control;
6. Fasting enhances or sharpens our sensitivity to the spirit of God and builds intimacy with God.
 - a. During the fast the hunger will keep your mind on God and that keeps you tuned to hear the voice of the spirit better.
 - b. The weakness of the flesh enhances the strength of the spirit in relation to the flesh. The voice of the spirit becomes louder over the cravings or urges or distractions of the flesh.


