MATTHEW 13:57-58 NKJV

So they were offended at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house." 58 Now He did not do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

What is Honor

- 1. Honor is a covenant platform for Promotion, recognition, impartation, longevity, preservation, supernatural supplies and abundance. 1Sam.2:30
- 2. Honor goes beyond mere respect or admiration. It encompasses recognition, reverence, value, gratitude and obedience. 1Pet.2:17
- 3. Honor is a spiritual force that has the potential to unlock the grace, favor, and blessings of God in our lives. Matt. 10:41

1 SAMUEL 2:30B NKJV

But now the Lord says: 'Far be it from Me; for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me shall be lightly esteemed.

"Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king."

What is Honor

- 4. Dr Mike Murdock, defines honor is the recognition, and celebration of the differences in others. Rom.13:7
- 5. Honor is one of the spiritual currencies for access and favors. It is an investment in relationships that secures divine rewards and the flow of supernatural grace. 2Kgs.2:9-10; 1Kgs.19:21
- 6. Honor means Adherence to Principles of Integrity. It is the commitment to maintaining one's integrity and acting in ways that reflect honesty, fairness, and responsibility Eph.4:25

ROMANS 13:7 NKJV

"Render therefore to all their due: taxes to whom taxes are due, customs to whom customs, fear to whom fear, honor to whom honor.

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2 KINGS 2:9-10 NKJV

And so it was, when they had crossed over, that Elijah said to Elisha, "Ask! What may I do for you, before I am taken away from you?" Elisha said, "Please let a double portion of your spirit be upon me." 10 So he said, "You have asked a hard thing. What is Honor

- Honor means alignment with God's order in the family, the church and the community. By living lives of honor—toward God, His servants, our parents, and those in need—we come into alignment with God's order in the family, church and community and open ourselves to the fullness of His favor and blessings.
- 8. You can give honor, and you can receive honor, but you cannot honor yourself. Jn.8:54

1 CORINTHIANS 9:27 NKJV

Jesus answered, "If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God

- 1. Honor is the covenant Platform for Blessings and Promotion. 1Sam.2:30b
 - a. Promotion comes through honor. You cannot be elevated without first honoring God and His vessels.
 - b. There were many sons of the prophet in the days of Prophet Elijah, but Elisha was promoted to take because he served and honored prophet Elijah. 2Kgs.2:15
 - c. Conversely, Gehazi did not take over the prophetic seat of prophet Elisha because he despised and disobeyed the man of God. 2Kgs.5:20-27

Now when the sons of the prophets who were from Jericho saw him, they said, "The spirit of Elijah rests on Elisha." And they came to meet him, and bowed to the ground before him.

 - a. The transference and impartation of graces, giftings and anointings is a function of honor.
 - b. You cannot receive what you despise. Gen.25:34
 - c. Reuben dishonored his father by sleeping with his father's concubine and lost the blessing of the first born to Joseph. Gen. 49:2-4;
 - d. You cannot partake of the grace that you do not serve or honor. Php.1:7; 4:19

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GENESIS 25:34 NKJV

And Jacob gave Esau bread and stew of lentils; then he ate and drank, arose, and went his way. Thus Esau despised his birthright.

- 3. Your preservation and longevity is a function of honor. Eph.6:1-3
 - a. Dishonoring authority or the individuals God has placed over us can lead to severe consequences. Num.12:1-15;
 - b. Mariam the elder sister of Moses was struck with Leprosy because she spoke against Moses. Num.12:1-15;
 - c. Koran Dathan and Abiram despised the authority of Moses and ended up swallowed by the earth along with their families. Num.16:31-33;

EPHESIANS 6:1-3 NKJV

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: 3 "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."

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 - a. Every prophet, pastor or servant of God carries a reward that can be accessed by honor.

 Matt. 10:40-41
 - b. Because the Philippians honored Paul with their giving, they had access to His God who shall supply all their needs according to His riches in glory Php.4:15-19

PROVERBS 3:9-10 NKJV

Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; 10 So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

- 5. Honor Is the cure for shame.
 - a. shame is the loss of a person's sense of dignity or worth. Honor Restores Dignity and Identity by providing validation from God or others.
 - b. The power of honor lifts people from the depths of disgrace to the heights of glory.
 - c. When honor is applied, it replaces the sting of shame with the sweetness of dignity, blessing, and purpose. Isa.61:7

ISALAH 61:7 NKJV

Instead of your shame you shall have double honor, And instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore in their land they shall possess double; Everlasting joy shall be theirs.

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- 6. Honor is a cornerstone of healthy relationships, Rom.12:10
 - a. It is through honor that we create an environment of mutual respect, understanding, and love.
 - b. Honor cultivates an atmosphere where individuals feel valued, and this sense of worth fosters love, unity, and cooperation.
 - c. Without honor, relationships become strained, and unity is hard to achieve.

ROMANS 12:10 NKJY

Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another."
