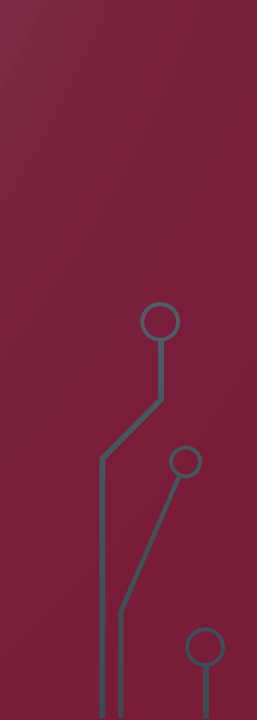
Its Important To Recognize That

1. Adams first response to God after the fall is to admit his fear. Gen.3:10
2. On resurrection Morning the first thing the Angels said to the women who came to look for Jesus was do not be afraid. Matt.28:5;
3. The first thing Jesus said to his disciples after the resurrection was to dispel their fears. Jn.20:19;
4. The most common command in the Bible is “do not be afraid or fear not.
5. Fear is the most common problem of Mankind. Heb.2:14-15

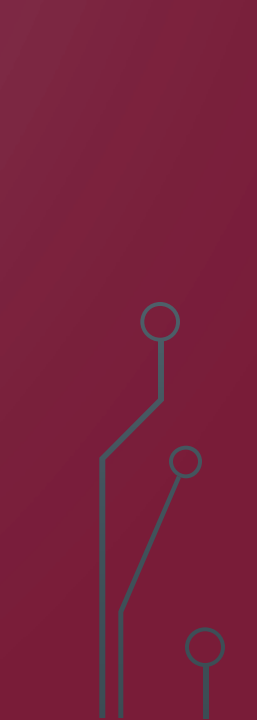

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

What is Fear

1. Psychologists use the word "phobia" to describe fears. Phobias are fears that have no basis in fact. It's a feeling of apprehension, anxiety or terror that has no basis in fact or truth. Matt.10:29-31; 6:25-27
2. Fear is the mind's prediction or expectation of an unwanted negative event based on the possibility not the probability of the event occurring. To the fearful mind what is possible seems probable.
 - a. Fear is **False Evidence Appearing Real**

MATTHEW 10:29-31 NKJV

Are not two sparrows sold for a [a]copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will. 30 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. 31 Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.

MATTHEW 6:25-27 NKJV

“Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? 26 Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? 27 Which of you by worrying can add one [a]cubit to his [b]stature?”

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What is Fear

3. Fear is a heartfelt emotion that begins with a fearful or unbelieving thought. The root of all fears is in our thinking or imagination.

Prov.23:7;

- a. Whenever you are afraid, it is because you have believed a lie of the devil or doubted the word of God and allowed your imagination to run unchecked with that lie. That is why to be free of fear you must reject fearful thoughts and replace them with the word of God.
- b. Peter walked on water until he doubted. Matt.14:29-30

MATTHEW 14:29-30 NKJV

So He said, “Come.” And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw [a]that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, “Lord, save me!

What is Fear

4. Fear is made up of 4 ingredients that Satan mixes to create terror in our hearts
 - a. Ignorance or limited knowledge of the word of God or the future. Hos.4:6; Jn.8:32; 2Cor.2:11
 - b. The creative capacity of our imagination. Lev.26:36
 - c. A painful personal experience or that of others you know. Eph.4:27; Isa.33:18a
 - d. A threat of harm. Neh.4:7-8

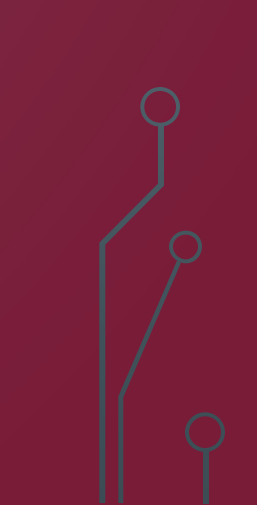

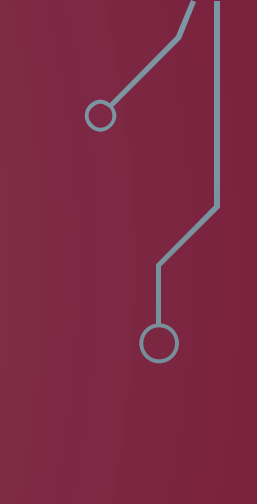
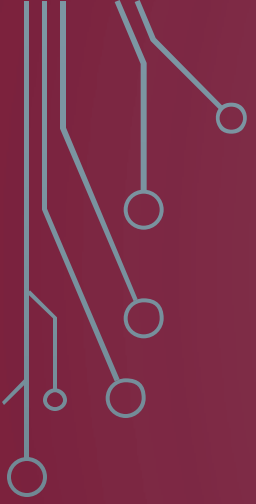

5. Fear is a spirit. 2Tim.1:7

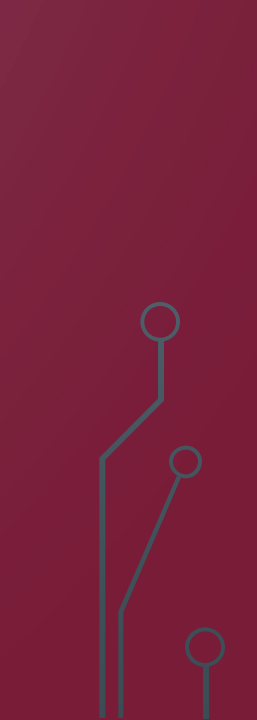
6. Fear is bondage. Fear immobilizes. Fear cripples.

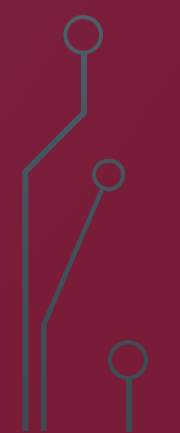
PRAYER 2
