What Is An Honest Estimation Of Oneself?

- a. There are 4 different ways to see or estimate yourself.
 - i. Your own image of yourself
 - ii. The way others see or think about you
 - iii. The way the devil sees or thinks of you
 - iv. The way God sees or thinks of you.
- b. Until the way you see yourself lines up with the way God sees you, you do not have an accurate or honest estimation of yourself
- c. And without an honest estimation of yourself you are incapable of humility.
