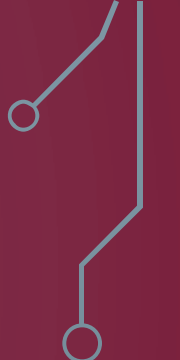
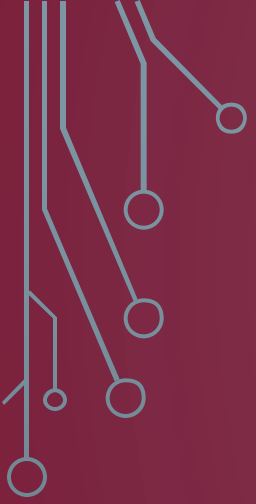

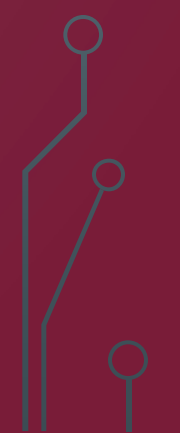
How To Overcome Pride And Arrogance

1. Recognize that the battle of pride is a daily one therefore:
 - a. Watch and pray. Prayerfulness is a demonstration of dependence on God and will keep pride away from you. Prayerlessness is evidence of pride. *Matt.26:41*
 - b. Examine yourself daily. That is what you do at your daily prayer altar. *2Cor.13:5; Ps.26:2*
 - c. Guard your heart. Do not allow thoughts of pride, haughtiness and arrogance to take root in your heart. *Prov.4:23*

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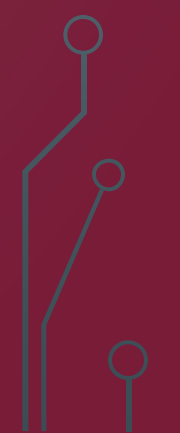
2. Think soberly of yourself. Rom.12:3
