- Order refers to the proper arrangement of things. It refers to the structure and placement of things which determines flow and efficiency in the achievement and maximization of the purpose for which that thing was created. Gen.1:1-3; Ex.25:40
- 2. Order refers to the proper alignment of things. Alignment refers to the correct positioning of something relative to another. You can have something that is organized or arranged but not properly aligned. 2Cor.5:15; Matt.6:33; Eph.5:25;

### EXODUS 25:40 NKJV

And see to it that you make them according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain.

#### What Is Order

- 3. Order refers to the proper functioning of things. It is one thing for things to be properly arranged, it is another for them to be properly aligned but it is a completely different thing for them to function the way they were created and ordained to function. Heb.1:3
- 4. Order refers to following or observing the proper procedures. God has protocols, procedures and conditions for interacting with him. When these are not followed access to him cannot be guaranteed. You cannot serve God on your own terms. Gen.4:3-5; Lev.10:1-2;

#### What Is Order

- 5. Order refers to the adequate supply of things necessary for divine order to reign. Tit.1:5
  - d. It is difficult to keep your finances in order if enough is not coming in.
  - b. Many times, the reason things are out of order is because key elements needed for order are missing.
- 6. Order refers to staying in your lane; marching in your column; not breaking ranks, marching in formation. Joel 2:7-8.
  - in a race if you enter someone else's lane, you are automatically disqualified.
