By Way Of Definitions

1. Praise is to celebrate and magnify the Lord for who He is, what He has done and what He will do.
2. New things are new positive experiences or possessions.
3. New chapters are new levels or opportunities
4. And open doors are access or opportunities for progress.
5. So praise for new things, new chapters and open doors is to celebrate or magnify God to provoke new experiences, new opportunities, new levels and access to progress and the desires of our hearts.

How does Praise Provoke New things, New Chapters & Open Doors

3. Praise is evidence that you love God because it is a selfless act that takes the attention and focus from you to God. 1Cor.2:9
