The Battle With the Tongue Pt. 3 Shiloh Bible Study

PSALM 120:3 NKJV

What shall be given to you, Or what shall be done to you, You false tongue?

- 1. Get born again. Because the tongue cannot be effectively tamed by the natural will of man. Being born again removes your tongue from under the power of darkness to light. Rom.6:13-14;

 - a. The baptism of the Holy Ghost releases power into your life for victorious living and testifying. Acts 1:8
 - b. Praying in tongues brings my tongue and my life under the power of the Holy Spirit because when I pray in tongues my spirit prays. 1Cor.14:14; 1Cor.6:17
 - c. By bringing your tongue under the power of the Holy Spirit, praying in tongues also purifies the tongue, like the purification of Prophet Isaiah's tongue in Isa.6:5-7; 2Thess.2:13
