GENESIS 12:1-3 NKJV

Now the Lord had said to Abram: “Get out of your country, From your family And from your father’s house, To a land that I will show you. 2 I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

The Laws of Kingdom Prosperity.

1. You must believe that God wants you to prosper.
Heb.11:6;
2. You cannot prosper above the level of prosperity of your soul. 3Jn.2
3. You cannot prosper beyond your degree of willingness and commitment to be a blessing to others . That is God will only bless you to the capacity of your willingness to be a blessing to others. Gen.12:2-3

GENESIS 12:2-3 NKJV

I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

What Does Kingdom Prosperity Law # 3 Mean

- a. It means God will not give you beyond your willingness and commitment to give to others. Lk.6:38
- b. It means your prosperity is limited by your willingness and commitment to be a blessing unto others. Prov.11:24-25; 2 Cor.9:6
- c. If you must be rich, you must be willing to share with others. 1Tim.6:17-19
- d. You were created and redeemed to be a blessing. The reason God wants to bless you is to make you a blessing to others. Eph.2:10

LUKE 6:38 NKJV

Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

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PROVERBS 11:24-25 NKJV

*There is one who scatters, yet increases more; And there is one who withholds more than is right, But it leads to poverty.
25 The generous soul will be made rich, And he who waters will also be watered himself.*

2 CORINTHIANS 9:6

6 But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows [a]bountifully will also reap [b]bountifully.

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1 TIMOTHY 6:17-19 NKJV

Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. 18 Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, 19 storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

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EPHESIANS 2:10 NKJV

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

What Are Those Good Works.

- I. Being a blessing to God and the kingdom. Matt.6:33
 - a) Making God and the interest of the kingdom the primary consideration in the allocation of your time, your talent and your treasures.
 - b) Be wholeheartedly invested in the growth and glory of the Church which is the kingdom of God here on earth.
 - c) Consistent tithing is proof of your commitment to be a blessing to God and His kingdom. It is one of the evidences that you are putting God first.
 - d) It is the blessing of the Lord that makes rich and you attract that blessing when you bring the tithe to Him. Prov.10:22; Mal.3:10

MATTHEW 6:33 NKJV

*But seek first the kingdom of God
and His righteousness, and all these
things shall be added to you.*

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PROVERBS 10:22 NKJV

The blessing of the Lord makes one rich, And He adds no sorrow with it.

MALACHI 3:10

Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this,” Says the Lord of hosts, “If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.

What Are Those Good Works.

II. Being a blessing to the blessed. Gen.12:3; Gal.6:10

- a) Being a blessing to those who are blessed connects you to the blessing that they carry. Matt.10:40-42;
- b) Sowing into the life of the blessed is tapping into their realm of harvest. Php.1:7; 4:15-19;
- c) Being a blessing to the blessed/anointed is connecting the mantle on their life to tackle the battles of your life. 2Kgs.4:8-37

GENESIS 12:3 NKJV

I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

GALATIANS 6:10

Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

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MATTHEW 10:40-42 NKJV

“He who receives you receives Me, and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me. 41 He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet’s reward. And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man’s reward. 42 And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward.”

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PHILIPPIANS 1:7 NKJV

just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart, inasmuch as both in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers with me of grace.

What Are Those Good Works.

III. Being a blessing to your family.

- a) There is a reason you were born to that family and you have a responsibility to be a blessing to them. Eph.6:1-3
- b) If you are living luxuriously in the city and your parents are in the village struggling to eat you are under a curse. You will not prosper the kingdom way.
- c) In the same vein if you are living luxuriously and your wife and children are struggling or suffering you are under a curse. You cannot prosper the kingdom way. 1 Tim.5:8

EPHESIANS 6:1-3 NKJV

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 2 “Honor your father and mother,” which is the first commandment with promise: 3 “that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.”

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1 TIMOTHY 5:8 NKJV

But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

What Are Those Good Works.

- IV. Be a blessing to the poor, the weak, the widows and orphans. Jas.1:27; Prov.19:17
- V. Be a blessing to your employees, friends, colleagues, community and anyone who crosses your path. Gal.6:10; Lev.19:13
- VI. Be Salt of the earth and Light of the world. Be the solution to the decadence and darkness of the earth. Be the solution to the problems of your world and the world. Matt.5:13-16

JAMES 1:27 NKJV

Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world.

PROVERBS 19:17

*He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord,
And He will pay back what he has given.*

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GALATIANS 6:10 NKJV

Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

LEVITICUS 19:13

‘You shall not cheat your neighbor, nor rob him. The wages of him who is hired shall not remain with you all night until morning.

Proof of Your Willingness and commitment...

The proof that you are willing and committed to be a blessing is what you are doing now.

1. Are you a blessing to God and the kingdom (your church) now?
2. Are you a blessing to the blessed now?
3. Are you a blessing to your family now?
4. Are you a blessing to the poor now?
5. Are you a blessing to your employees, friends and community now?
6. Are you salt and light to your world now?

LUKE 16:10-12 NKJV

He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. 11 Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? 12 And if you have not been faithful in what is another man's, who will give you what is your own?
