



HOW TO DEPLOY YOUR FAITH, PT. 3

Miracle Sunday

JAMES 5:14-15 NKJV

Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. 15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

How to Deploy Your Faith

1. By Word or faith-filled thought.

- a. Your thoughts determine your outcome. And God responds to your thoughts. Ps.23:7a; Eph.3:20;
- b. That is why we must allow the word of God to shape our thoughts. So, our thoughts will line up with and God's agenda for our lives. Rom.12:2; Eph.4:23

2. By Word or faith filled declarations.

- a. Your declaration is the covenant trigger for manifestation. Job 22:28
- b. Your words carry and releases your faith. Mk.16:17

How to Deploy Your Faith

3. By Word or faith-based actions.

- a. It's not enough to talk the talk, you must take actions in line with your confession or declaration or the word of God.

2Cor.5:7; Heb.10:38

- b. Because action is the switch of supernatural power. It is the trigger for supernatural release. Lk.6:19

- c. Every promise of God places a demand on the obedience of man for that promise to manifest. Deploying your faith means obeying the instructions demanded by that promise.

Deut.28:1-2; Lk.5:4-7;

So it was, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned for many days; I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven. 5 And I said: "I pray, Lord God of heaven, O great and awesome God, You who keep Your covenant and mercy with those who love [a]You and observe [b]Your commandments, 6 please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel which we have sinned against You. Both my father's house and I have sinned.

NEHEMLAH 1:7-9 NKJV
