#1 - JESUS IS THE BETTER EXPERIENCE (v1:4,6-8)

I. Angels Are Under Authority

- 1. We like the idea of meeting with the divine
 - (1) Other religions teach we can ascend to God (new series)
 - (2) Only in Christianity does God descend to us.

II. Jesus Is In Authority

MATT. 28:18 | And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me..."

- 1. He is claiming to be God
 - (1) No other religion
 - i. Krishna, Mohammad, Budah
 - (2) "I and the Father are one..."
 - i. Christianity is never offensive by what it does. It is always offensive by what it says.
- 2. Which Gives Him Authority
 - (1) He has authority over angels because he has all authority over all creation,
 - i. You are not an independent person, you were created to be a dependent person.
 - (2) Haircut: All God's are the same
 - i. There is one God for all people, for all nations, for all genders (Rev. 7)
 - ii. Inclusive/Exclusive
 - (3) You will give an account to this King, to this ruler, to this Savior.

#2 - JESUS IS THE BETTER ADVOCATE (v3:3-4, 7:23-28)

I. People Are Sinful



- 1. I dare you to find any fault, flaw or failure.
 - (1) Even if you don't believe in sin, even if you're not a particularly religious person
 - i. "Nobody's perfect"
 - ii. I don't care what Oprah says, you can never be your best "you" now.
 - (2) Sin includes:
 - i. Thoughts, motives, inclinations, feelings, actions (omission/comission)

II. Jesus Is Perfect

JN. 8:46 | "Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me?"

- 1. Sin isn't just between people:
 - (1) We have all been sinned against
 - (2) We have all sinned against others
 - (3) But all sin is about God (Psalm 154)
- 2. Jesus is a perfect substitute
 - (1) You don't need to hide your side, deny your sin, or minimize your sin.
 - (2) You can have you sin forgiven.
 - (3) "Pharisees: who can forgive sin but God alone".

#3 - JESUS IS THE BETTER REST (v4:8-13)

I. Our Rest Is Superficial

- Haircut: Going golfing
 - (1) This culture is more anxious, more confused, more unsettled...than any culture in our history.
 - (2) And we are constantly looking for someone, somewhere, someway to be at peace and be at rest.
 - (3) If we are not perfect, if we are flawed, if we have faults...then it would stand to reason we are limited in our capacity for self-reflections, self-awareness, and self-assessment.
 - i. If we just elect the right leader
 - ii. If I just go the right places
 - iii. If I just find the right hobby
 - iv. If I just work at the right job

II. Jesus' Rest Is Surgical

MATT. 11:28-29 | "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

- 1. Something deeper that undermines your rest
 - (1) What are you putting your faith in?



(2) Put your faith in Jesus

#4 - JESUS IS THE BETTER PROMISE (v7:22, 18-21a)

I. Promises Are Fickle

- 1. Everyone in here has broken a promise or has had a promise made to them broken.
 - (1) Relationship promises
 - (2) Vocational promises
 - (3) Consumer promises
- 2. Promises are important to us because assurance is important to us.
 - (1) No one in here wants to waste their time

II. Covenants Are Fixed

LUKE 22:20 | "And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."

- 1. If you put your faith in Jesus...
 - (1) You can be assured that He does what says He does
 - (2) He does not change His mind, He does not go back on what he says, no 'take backs', no 'just kiddings', no 'fingers crossed'.
 - (3) When He says that He alone saves and the He alone give rest...it is because He alone that brokered the covenant assuring us of such a claim.
 - i. When you buy a car, the salesman didn't build it

#5 - JESUS IS THE BETTER PLACE (v11:16)

I. Places Are For Wandering

- 1. I have lived in 18 different houses over the course of my life.
 - (1) My gen. and millennial are the most transient in history.
 - (2) However, very few people, if any, in this room, can say they have had one permanent place their entire lives.
 - i. Places are for wandering

II. Jesus Is For Settling

JN. 14:1-3 | "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also."

- 1. Jesus is not on here
 - (1) Buddhists can go to Sri Lanka and visit the Temple of the Tooth
 - (2) Mormons can go to Illinois and take pictures of the Smith Family Cemetery in Illinois
 - (3) Muslims can go to Saudi Arabia and see the Mosque of the Prophet
