VII. DEATH OF JESUS - LIFE OF JESUS

A. AFFLICTED BUT NOT CRUSHED

[2 Corinthians 4:17 - For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison . . .]

- 1. Still have room to breathe
- 2. Never without a way out
- 3. In his death, we're crushed by affliction.
- 4. But in his life, we're crushed by the weight of Glory.

B. PERPLEXED BUT NOT DRIVEN TO DESPAIR

[Ephesians 1:18-19 - . . . having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might . . .]

- But not to the point of surrender
- 2. But never to the point of being completely lost.
- 3. In His death, we despair with darkened hearts and minds
- 4. In His life, our hearts are enlightened to the hope He's called us to

C. <u>PERSECUTED</u> BUT NOT FORSAKEN

[1 Samuel 12:22 - For the Lord will not forsake his people, for his great name's sake, because it has pleased the Lord to make you a people for himself.]

- Never abandoned
- 2. Never left to figure it out alone
- 3. In His death, we are forsaken and alone.
- 4. In His life,

[1 Samuel 12:22 - He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again.]
