

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, what is something you are thankful for or something you would like prayer for?
- 2) Last week, we talked about the present realities of heaven and hell. Were you able to breathe a bit of heaven into anyone's life this week?
- 3) Read Revelation 11:1-13 and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What stands out to you? (*Lampstands represent the Church (Rev 1:20, Zech 4). The number 7 represents fullness; so, half of 7 (three and a half) represents something temporary (not yet full): e.g. 42 months and 1,260 days, which are each 3.5 years.*)
- 4) Sodom, Egypt, Babylon, and Jerusalem (where Jesus was crucified) are all symbols for the systems/empires of evil in the world. Where do you see injustice and innocent suffering today?
- 5) Read Revelation 12:11 (below). The witnesses gave their lives in love for God and others, and it is through that love that people gave God glory (Rev 11:13). How is God calling you to lay down your life in love for others this week?
- 6) Close in prayer. Pray for the needs of our community/world and for opportunities to represent His love so that people can meet Jesus and be transformed.
