- 4) Read Psalm 24:1-6. Jesus knew this psalm; do you see any connections to today's beatitudes?
- 5) How does Jesus exemplify each of these three qualities (hunger for righteousness, mercy, and purity of heart)?
- 6) The pure in heart will "see God." How have you learned to recognize God?
- 7) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
