

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, what is something you are thankful for or something you would like prayer for?
- 2) How did you see God during Holy Week and Easter?
- 3) Read the passages and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. (*The Lamb is Jesus and the scroll represents God's plan to bring His Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven.*) What stands out to you?
- 4) Jesus is declared worthy to receive power and glory because He gave up His life. How does this contrast to the way people try to get power in our world?
- 5) Read verse 9 again. What does this tell us about the character of God?
- 6) What does it tell us about the nature of God's people (every tribe, nation, etc.)?
- 7) Priests represented people to God and God to people. How are we called to represent Jesus in the world today?
- 8) Close in prayer. Lift up the needs of people in your life to God. Ask Him to show you ways that you can represent Jesus to those people this week.
