- 4) How are we tempted to live for ourselves?

- 6) We are also entrusted with a "ministry of reconciliation." How has Jesus' love changed you? How can you share that with others?
- 7) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
