

## CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) How have you seen God work in your life this week?
- 2) How have you struggled to obey God's Word and live out your faith in Christ this week?
- 3) Where do you most feel at home? Have you ever been in a place where you felt you didn't belong?
- 4) Read Matthew 5:3-5. Jesus is *not* saying that we should try to *become* spiritually poor, or grieved, or powerless. He is proclaiming Good News: even people that are experiencing such things *belong* in God's Kingdom! Read Luke 15:11-31; does this story help you sense Jesus' tone in Matthew 5?
- 5) How can we join Jesus in announcing this Good News? Who in your life feels faraway from God? Who are the people we need to welcome into God's Kingdom? Who needs to know they belong?
- 6) Take a moment to praise God, to pray for the needs of your group and our church, and to ask for God's guidance in the coming week.
