

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, what is something you are thankful for or something you would like prayer for?
- 2) Last week, we talked about the power Jesus gives us to be vulnerable for the sake of others. God gives us opportunities to tell others how He has saved, transformed and provided for us. What opportunities did God give you this week? How did you respond?
- 3) Read the passage and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What stands out to you?
- 4) We find the disciples in a season of waiting: Jesus gave them a mission, but they don't yet have the power of the Holy Spirit. What kinds of things have you waited for? (Healing, guidance, provision, etc.) How did you feel in the waiting?
- 5) The disciples' waiting is not passive: they are constantly praying (v14), mediating on Scripture (v20), and preparing for their mission (v21-25). What can you remove from your life this week in order to make more space for prayer and waiting on God?
- 6) The disciples prayed *together*. Take time to do that now. You might make space for each person to pray and be prayed for, and you might need to split into smaller groups to facilitate that. Seek God together.
