- 5) *Looking* good became more important to Ananias and Sapphira than actually *being* good. How have you experienced that temptation in your life?
- 6) Through Ananias and Sapphira's lie, the devil was trying to attack the Church. How have you seen the unfaithfulness and hypocrisy of Christians damage the impression people have of God?
- 7) God's love frees us to live honestly (like Barnabas). How do you need to remember God's love for you this week? What is one way you can practice living honestly (instead of hiding or trying to impress)?
- 8) Close in prayer.
