

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, what is something you are thankful for or something you would like prayer for?
- 2) Last week, Revelation 5 emphasized that “if God is in control, we don’t have to be.” How did you practice releasing control to God this week?
- 3) Read Revelation 7:9-15, Revelation 9:1-11, and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What stands out to you?
- 4) Those who follow the Lamb “washed their robes” in His blood. Have you saturated your life in Jesus’ self-sacrificial love? How does this lead to life?
- 5) Is Jesus really your Shepherd? Have you laid down your life for Him, like He laid down His for you? Is there anything you still need to lay down?
- 6) Revelation 9 is trying to open our eyes. How do you see people experiencing hell on earth today?
- 7) Jesus came to earth to set us free from sin and death. Who is God calling you to set free through His love?
- 8) Close in prayer. Pray for those who haven’t found Christ, and pray for eyes to really see them. Pray for God to use us to bring His Kingdom on earth as in heaven, and for Him to use us to do it.
