

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, how was God at work in your life? Is there some way we can pray for you?
- 2) Last week, we talked about waiting and prayer. How did you practice waiting on God this week? Did you spend more time in prayer? What did you hear?
- 3) Read the passage and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What did you learn? What stands out to you?
- 4) The Holy Spirit enables people of all languages to hear the Gospel, and Peter quotes Joel: "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." What does this tell us about God and His Kingdom?
- 5) Before people can receive the Holy Spirit, Peter says they need to "repent and be baptized" (Acts 2:38). To repent is to "turn around" from our selfish sin and to make Christ our King. How has this transformed you?
- 6) Read Acts 2:40-41 and 1 Peter 3:15. How comfortable are you talking to non-Christians about your faith? How do we do this with "gentleness and respect"?
- 7) Take a few deep breaths: recognize God's presence. Close in prayer: invite the Holy Spirit into our lives. Ask God to use us this week to draw people to Him.
