

CONNECT QUESTIONS

- 1) Thinking about this week, how was God at work in your life? Is there some way we can pray for you?
- 2) Last week, we planned to practice trusting God and embodying the generous love of Acts 2. How did you live that out? What was difficult or encouraging?
- 3) Read the passage and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What did you learn? What stands out to you?
- 4) This man would sit at the gate of the temple every day: just outside of God's presence. What tends to keep you from embracing God's presence?
- 5) This man just wants some money, but God wants to heal him. God wants so much more for us than we expect. Where are you settling in your life?
- 6) The man doesn't look up until told to. What leads you to hide from others or from God?
- 7) Peter and John truly *see* this man, and their faith heals him. Who does God want you to see? How might seeing someone with grace bring healing?
- 8) Take a moment to listen in silence. Ask God, "Where do you want to open my eyes?" Commit to see people with grace this week, and expect God to give you opportunities to speak healing over someone.
