- 1) Thinking about this week, what is something you are thankful for or something you would like prayer for?

- 3) *Everyone* is created in the image of God. How should this change the way we treat people?

- 6) Why is it so important that God adopted us into His family? How can we help each other live out our identity as chosen children of God?
