- 3) Read Acts 5:41, 6:13-15, 7:51-59 and reflect on the sermon from Sunday. What stands out to you?
- 4) Stephen saw Jesus, but the religious leaders covered their ears. What are some things that can distract us from hearing God's voice or seeing what He's doing?
- 5) What motivated Stephen to pray for his murderers?
- 6) An old hymn says, "Turn your eyes upon Jesus and the things of earth will grow strangely dim." Can you think of a time when focusing on Jesus changed your perspective on a difficult situation? What happened?
- 7) When life gets stressful or painful, what are you tempted to focus on instead of Jesus?
- 8) This week, what is one burden, fear, distraction, or relationship that you need to place at Jesus' feet? How can you intentionally keep your eyes on Him?
- 9) Pray for each other. Close by playing or singing the chorus of "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus" together.
