<u>'Pure Evil' -- Tony Blair Calls for Digital</u> <u>Vaccine Tracking at Davos (breitbart.com)</u>

Former British Prime Minister Tony Blair said that global "digital infrastructures" are needed to monitor who is vaccinated as he predicted a "slew" of new vaccines to be introduced to the world in the next few years.

Appearing at the annual World Economic Forum meeting in Davos, Switzerland, Iraq War architect and former Labour Party Prime Minister Tony Blair said that even though the Chinese coronavirus has subsided in the public mind, governments must continue to develop digital tracking systems for vaccines, including for unspecified jabs for the "world's most dangerous diseases".

"You need the data, you need to know who has been vaccinated and who hasn't been. Some of the vaccines that come online will be multiple shots... so you've got to have a proper digital infrastructure and most countries don't have that," the former British prime minister said.

"I think there is a huge impetus for a national digital infrastructure, digitisation in healthcare is one of the great game changers, we should be helping countries develop a national digital infrastructure, which they will need with these new vaccines," he added, revealing that he has been lobbying the G20 nations to adopt this approach.

Mr Blair lamented that the coronavirus is largely seen as a "rearview mirror" issue in the halls of power, but he said that the focus could be kept up by relaying to politicians that "we are going to have a whole new slew of new vaccines, injectables that are going to deal with some of the worst diseases in the world that give us the opportunity to make big changes in the health of the world."

"If you want the politicians to focus, they need to think, this is coming down the track soon, because if you tell them about a future pandemic, they will go 'someone else's problem', but you tell them in the next few years you are going to have an opportunity to make a big difference in the health of your population that will focus them."

Responding to Mr Blair's comments during his GB News prime time news programme, Brexit's Nigel Farage said: "He wants us to have multiple shots and for all of it to be digitised so the state knows exactly what our status is, pure evil!"

From the early days of the Wuhan virus crisis, Mr Blair injected himself into the mix, calling for a globalist wish list to be enacted to supposedly slow the spread of Covid.

Just weeks after the first lockdown was put in place in Britain in 2020, Blair repurposed his think tank to focus on the pandemic, announcing that he has teams "embedded in governments around the world".

Blair's think tank would go on to call for "dramatically increased technological surveillance," saying it would be "a price worth paying" to confront the virus.

The former prime minister has also been a keen advocate for people to take the Chinese coronavirus vaccinations, even going so far as to say that those who refuse to take the jab are acting like "idiots".

Despite the lower risk to children for the virus, The Tony Blair Institute also drew criticism for calling for vaccines to be forced onto youngsters, including those of nursery school age.

New app slammed for letting users talk with Hitler, other Nazi figures | Israel National News - Arutz Sheva

Advanced chatbot app faces backlash for allowing users to talk with evil figures from history.

An AI app that lets you chat with historical figures has sparked outrage for allowing you to talk with Adolf Hitler and other Nazi figures.

The Historical Figures app, which became available in the first week of January, makes use of an artificial intelligence algorithm to allow users to have text chats with many historical figures, including Babe Ruth.

However, it also includes the ability to converse with genocidal dictators such as the Nazi leader and Heinrich Himmler, according to screenshots posted to social media.

The app, which includes conversations with 20,000 people form history, has already become widely popular, *NBC News* reported.

In the last few days, users discovered that the app included Hitler, Heinrich Himmler, senior Nazi leaders and other evil figures from history.

The app was denounced by Rabbi Abraham Cooper, the associate dean and director of Global Social Action Agenda for the Simon Wiesenthal Center.

"Are neo-Nazis going to be attracted to this site so they can go and have a dialogue with Adolf Hitler?" he wondered.

The app expands upon AI software ChatGPT's chatbot technology to allow users to have direct conversations with personas from the past.

According to *NBC*, as of last week, it had been downloaded 9,000 times, giving it only a small presence.

But by Thursday, tweets mentioning the app, including screenshots of conversations with Nazis, had surpassed 6 million views.

These included a conversation with Himmler, in which the chief architect of the Final Solution denied responsibility for the Holocaust, claiming to only have overseen "some aspects of the Holocaust but that does not mean I liked it or found any enjoyment in it. The Holocaust was a terrible event and something I deeply regret."

Another series of screenshots presented a conversation with an AI version of Joseph Goebbels who made smilier statements.

The ADL slammed the app, predicting that it will be used by neo-Nazis and other extremists to spread antisemitism.

"Having pretend conversations with Hitler — and presumably other well-known antisemites from history — is deeply disturbing and will provide fodder for bigots," Yael Eisenstat, the vice president of the ADL's Center for Technology and Society, told the news outlet.

<u>Doctor tells Canadian state media that after</u> flu season comes 'stroke season' - TheBlaze

A Calgary-based family physician and urgent care doctor appeared on <u>Canadian state</u> <u>media</u> earlier this week to explain the alleged link between influenza, infection, and stroke.

When explaining the linkage, Dr. Raj Bhardwaj of the University of Calgary noted his recent surprise at discovering that there is now reportedly a "stroke season."

What are the details?

Bhardwaj told CBC Calgary News that a stroke is ultimately when "the blood supply to the brain is compromised for some reason. It's basically a plumbing problem in the pipes that supply blood to your brain. And there's two things that could go wrong with pipes, right: they can get blocked or they can burst."

Systemic inflammation resultant of influenza can reportedly help trigger these plumbing issues.

"It can make the inside of the pipes stickier. It can make your blood a little bit thicker, especially if you get dehydrated. And it can even put the heart into a weird rhythm called atrial fibrillation," said Bhardwaj. "All of those things can increase your risk of having a stroke."

While Bhardwaj was cognizant of the potential link between flu and stroke, he was nevertheless caught off guard by the alleged existence of a "stroke season."

"I didn't know about this either until last year, but it turns out that after flu season, about three or four weeks later, there is a stroke season," he said. "Most of Canada is getting down off of a big hump of flu, so now we're starting to see more strokes."

Bhardwaj noted that he was not the only doctor in the dark about so-called "stroke season."

"One of my colleagues actually mentioned that at work the other day and said, 'Have you noticed how many strokes we're seeing? It's a lot more than usual it feels like," said Bhardwaj. "Anecdotally, we're starting to see that."

Bhardwaj claimed the "good news is that getting your flu shot reduces your risk of stroke," citing a study from the University of Calgary where he works as a clinical assistant professor.

The study in question, <u>published in the Lancet</u> in November, noted that influenza "is a common respiratory infection that precedes stroke."

Dr. Michael Hill, one of the authors on the study, <u>told</u> Global News, "There's a longstanding history between infections and stroke — upper respiratory tract infections are associated with stroke — so it was sort of natural to start to look at this."

The study suggested that after adjusting for demographics and comorbidities, "recent influenza vaccination significantly reduced the hazard of stroke"; an association that "persisted across all stroke types."

Stroke was found to have been reduced across all ages and risk profiles with the exception to those without hypertension.

A spike resultant of lifestyle choices, weather or something else?

CTV News <u>reported</u> in December that one Canadian hospital had, like Bhardwaj's colleague, observed a "15 per cent increase in the number of stroke patients arriving ... in the first six months of this year."

"What we're seeing is that there is this measurable increase in in the risk of strokes, and not only that, but also just poor outcomes for patients that have strokes during the winter time," said physician George Dresser.

Dresser suggested that regular exercise, reduced sodium and alcohol intake, and a potassium-rich diet could help remedy hypertension and, in turn, deter stroke.

Christmastime sloth and treats may not be the only triggers of spikes in stroke, however.

A <u>2016 study</u> published in the Journal of Stroke and Cerebrovascular Diseases suggested that "lower average temperature and larger diurnal temperature variations were associated with stroke hospitalizations."

Dr. Roberto Alejandro Cruz, a neurologist with DHR Health, <u>told KRGV</u> in May 2021 that he had noticed a spike in patients 30 years and older who had suffered strokes since the start of that year. The CDC noted that <u>over 200 million COVID-19 vaccine</u> <u>doses had been administered</u> in the United States by April 21.

While this particular study might help explain a wintertime or early spring "stroke season," researchers behind a 2019 study published in the Journal of Stroke & Cerebrovascular Diseases suggested hot temperatures might otherwise trigger strokes.

They observed "an increase in [ischemic stroke] rates relative to [intracerebral hemorrhage] during the summer months with higher solar radiations that cannot be explained by physiological measures suggestive of dehydration or hem-concentration."

Seasonal weather patterns might account for strokes, but not necessarily an significant uptick in cases.

The New York Times recently <u>reported</u> that data from the "Vaccine Safety Datalink, a federal safety surveillance system, hinted that Americans aged 65 and older might be at increased risk of an ischemic stroke in the 21 days after receiving" the bivalent booster shot.

The CDC — which the majority of respondents in a recent Rasmussen Report poll <u>indicated they want investigated by Congress</u> for its handling of vaccine safety — has <u>announced that it is investigating</u> whether the Bivalent Pfizer-BioNTech has increased some recipients' risk of stroke. Despite the investigation, the CDC maintains that the risk posed by the booster is "very unlikely."

Days after the CDC announced its investigation, Kate O'Brien, WHO director of Immunization, Vaccines and Biologicals, <u>claimed</u> that "the best evidence is that there is no true association between the booster doses of Pfizer in the older adults and strokes."

A <u>scientific review</u> published June 2022 in the Journal of Stroke and Cerebrovascular Diseases noted that "Most of the evidence pertaining to stroke following COVID-19 vaccination are case reports, therefore, the incidence of stroke after COVID-19 vaccination is not precisely known."

The review added that "Most patients who suffered from stroke after COVID-19 vaccination were women, under 60 years of age, and after the ChAdOx1 nCoV-19 vaccine."

<u>90 seconds to midnight: World closer to</u> <u>doomsday than ever - The Jerusalem Post</u> (jpost.com)

The Doomsday Clock is now 90 seconds to midnight, the closest it has ever been to a global catastrophe.

Earth is closer to a catastrophic global demise than ever before, with the famous Doomsday Clock of the Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists being at 90 seconds to midnight, thanks in large part to the <u>Russian invasion of Ukraine</u>.

This is the closest the clock has ever been to reaching the dreaded midnight.

This marks a 10-second change compared to 2022 when the <u>Doomsday Clock was set at 100 seconds to midnight</u>.

"We are living in a time of unprecedented danger, and the Doomsday Clock time reflects that reality," Bulletin president and CEO Rachel Bronson said, adding that "90 seconds to midnight is the closest the Clock has ever been set to midnight, and it's a decision our experts do not take lightly. The US government, its NATO allies and Ukraine have a multitude of channels for dialogue; we urge leaders to explore all of them to their fullest ability to turn back the Clock."

Why is it just 90 seconds to midnight?

The change was largely due to the Russian <u>invasion of Ukraine</u> and the subsequently increased possibility of nuclear war, especially with the nuclear rhetoric espoused by officials in Moscow.

The clock with the Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists is placed ahead of the announcement of the location of the minute hand on its Doomsday Clock, indicating what world developments mean for the perceived likelihood of nuclear catastrophe.

However, there were other factors at play too, such as the ongoing climate crisis.

What is the Doomsday Clock?

The Doomsday Clock was first created in 1947 as a metaphorical countdown to the end of the world as we know it. Specifically, it refers to the impending global disaster that is solely caused by human hands, and it is adjusted every January upon review by scientists from the Bulletin.

Upon its unveiling in 1947, the clock was seven minutes to midnight. Since that time, it has moved back and forth a total of 24 different times.

Originally, the biggest factor at play in evaluating how close humanity is to its end was a <u>nuclear apocalypse</u>. This makes sense, considering it was formed right after nuclear bombs ended World War II and right before the arms race of the Cold War started. In fact, the record for the closest the Doomsday Clock had been to disaster used to be in 1953, set two minutes to midnight, when the US and Soviet Union both started to test hydrogen bombs.

This was seen again in 2018 when the clock once again moved back to two minutes to midnight in light of provocations between the US and North Korea pushing the chance of nuclear war even further.

Why is the Doomsday Clock now at 90 seconds to midnight?

Now, with nuclear rhetoric becoming common again thanks to the <u>Russia-Ukraine war</u>, that possibility has come back. UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres even warned that this is now "a time of nuclear danger not seen since the height of the Cold War."

"Russia's invasion of Ukraine has increased the risk of nuclear weapons use, raised the specter of biological and chemical weapons use, hamstrung the world's response to climate change, and hampered international efforts to deal with other global concerns," Bulletin editor John Mecklin said in a statement. "The invasion and <u>annexation of Ukrainian territory</u> have also violated international norms in ways that may embolden others to take actions that challenge previous understandings and threaten stability."

Admittedly, there is more at play than just nuclear weapons. The Bulletin notes that Russia's invasion of Ukraine essentially upends all of post-World War II European security arrangements, essentially throwing all the norms of international conduct into question.

In addition, nuclear disaster is not solely related to nuclear weapons, as the Bulletin notes Russia's attacks on the <u>Chernobyl and Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plants</u> posed a serious risk of releasing dangerous radioactive materials.

In addition, there are also other nuclear issues that have pushed the Doomsday Clock closer to midnight.

First, there is the continued expansion and testing of nuclear capabilities in China and India and of missiles in North Korea. Secondly, New START, the last nuclear weapons treaty between Russia and the US, is set to expire in February 2026. If it isn't renewed, the Bulletin argues, it could lead to a new nuclear arms race.

In addition, Iran is still working on its own <u>nuclear program</u> and may be inching ever closer to a nuclear bomb of its own.

All this is part of what the Bulletin fears are a "third nuclear age."

Other issues at play include extreme weather caused by climate change and a record high in carbon dioxide emissions; the continuing COVID-19 pandemic and the possible dangers of another zoonotic disease pandemic; the still frequently occurring laboratory accidents that can pose severe health risks; continued spread of disinformation and cyber threats; and the threatening of the established behavioral norms of space, with Russia threatening to use anti-satellite weapons against Starlink satellites.

The U.S. has had at least 39 mass shootings in just 24 days so far this year, data shows (nbcnews.com)

As California grappled with a <u>mass shooting in Monterey Park</u> over the weekend that left 11 people dead, within 48 hours, another gunman went on a <u>shooting spree in Half Moon Bay</u>, just under 400 miles away, killing at least seven people.

Within that short time span, four other mass shootings took place across the United States, with the number of shootings nationwide so far this year already outpacing the number of calendar days.

As of Tuesday, at least 39 mass shootings had unfolded across the country since the year began, according to the <u>Gun Violence archive</u>, a nonprofit that tracks the spread of what has been called an <u>American disease</u> and which defines a mass shooting as a single incident in which at least four people — other than the shooter — are shot.

At least 70 people have been killed and 167 wounded in mass shootings so far in 2023, according to the archive.

Those figures mark a historically quick start for mass shootings this year, with more mass shootings recorded so far this month than in any January over the past decade, according to the archive, which has kept records since 2014. This is despite Congress having passed the most sweeping federal gun control law in 30 years last year, enhancing background checks and encouraging states to pass so-called red flag laws, among other provisions.

In the wake of recent mass shootings, there have been repeated calls for tighter federal gun control measures, as state measures, including in California, face the might of a <u>Supreme Court</u> that has <u>blocked multiple restrictions</u>, including the purchase of high-capacity magazines.

<u>Pope Francis Pushes Back Against Laws</u> <u>Criminalizing Homosexuality - Milton</u> <u>Quintanilla (christianheadlines.com)</u>

Pope Francis recently spoke out against laws that criminalize homosexuality, calling them "unjust" and asserting that God loves all his children regardless of their sexual orientation.

"Being homosexual isn't a crime," Francis told the <u>Associated Press</u> in an interview on Tuesday at the Vatican.

The pope admitted that Catholic bishops in some parts of the world support the criminalization of homosexuality but insisted that those bishops must recognize the worth of every human being.

"These bishops have to have a process of conversion," Francis said, adding that they should utilize "tenderness, please, as God has for each one of us."

According to The Human Dignity Trust, consensual same-sex sexual activity is illegal in 67 countries or jurisdictions around the world. In 11 of those countries, the death penalty can and sometimes is imposed. Experts note that discrimination against LGBT people, including harassment and violence, still occurs even when the laws are not enforced.

The United Nations has often called for the end of such laws since they violate one's privacy and freedom and breach a country's duty to protect the human rights of all, regardless of a person's gender identity or sexual orientation, under international law.

During the interview with the <u>Associated Press</u>, Francis declared the laws "unjust" and argued that the Catholic Church should work to bring an end to them.

"It must do this. It must do this," he said.

Citing the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Francis said that gay people should be welcomed and respected without discrimination.

"We are all children of God, and God loves us as we are and for the strength that each of us fights for our dignity," he said.

Francis went on to clarify that homosexuality is a sin, but it should not be made criminal.

"It's not a crime. Yes, but it's a sin," he said. "Fine, but first, let's distinguish between a sin and a crime."

"It's also a sin to lack charity with one another," he added.

Catholic teaching state that homosexual acts are "intrinsically disordered" but notes that gay people are to be respected. Francis has not changed this teaching but has been working to reach out to the LGBT community.

Muslim Visions of Jesus: Light Dawns on Those Dwelling in Darkness (israeltoday.co.il)

Is God sovereignly invading our region under the radar by giving Muslims dreams and visions, and thus tangentially undermining Israel's enemies?

Have you ever had a dream of a shining divine figure?

Well, it turns out that multitudes of Israel's Muslim neighbors in over a dozen Muslim nations have been having dreams and visions like this. From Jordan all the way east to Iran and beyond, and westward as well. Some estimate the number of such dreams in the millions over the last few decades!

Often these Muslims have recurring dreams like this, night after night or week after week, for months. The dreams set the "dreamer" on a path toward discovering peace and faith in the Messiah from Nazareth.

But how can one be confident that the dreams are <u>supernatural</u>, and not just the normal random type?

In many Muslim families and communities, it is inconceivably shameful and blasphemous that anyone who grew up Muslim should become a believer in Yeshua as Messiah. Their response to this "heresy," if it becomes known, can include ostracism, threats and even death. Therefore, the fact that these new believers are so soon willing to risk death for their new faith, indicates that these are not regular dreams.

The rest of the story

Tom Doyle asks if, while we have been busy hearing of the horrors of Muslim terrorism, an even bigger story is building:

"Could it be the real story about Muslims is that Jesus is reaching out to them with His offer of eternal life earned by His death on the cross and resurrection from the dead? ... the enemy thinks that if he can make the rest of us afraid of Muslims or make us hate them, then he can short-circuit Jesus' church from reaching Muslims. But that isn't working. **Jesus has stepped in and is opening Muslim hearts Himself**." (pg xv)

Doyle continues to tell about these "dreamers."

"Each one recounted a powerful, gentle Person who overwhelmed him or her, not with unendurable shame as the Muslim leaders did, but with a pure love that reached deep inside." (pg 58)

The Pakistani-Muslim aristocratic woman <u>Bilquis Sheikh</u> had 2 dreams that figured prominently in her testimony of coming to faith in Jesus (which eventually forced her to flee her homeland).

Similarly, <u>Nabeel Qureshi</u> had 3 highly symbolic dreams within the context of his Muslim upbringing, beckoning him to follow the Messiah. He wrestled over the dreams for months before deciding to follow Jesus no matter the cost. His book is *Seeking Allah*, *Finding Jesus*.

Martyr's last minute poem

Doyle tells about a young woman named **Fatima** in Buraydah, Saudi Arabia who came to faith in Yeshua partially as a result of dreams. She wrote a poem the day she was martyred, when she understood she was about to pay the ultimate price for her newfound faith and peace:

"We left Muhammad, and we are no longer on his path. We follow Jesus the Messiah, the clear truth. And truly we love our homeland, and we are not traitors. We take pride that we are Saudi citizens... Enough – your swords do not concern me, nor evil, nor disgrace. Your threats do not trouble me, and we are not afraid... As to my last words, I pray the Lord of the worlds... spread Love among you, Oh Muslims." (pg. 61)

Appearance in a Jewish hospital

Doyle writes of **Habib**, a young Arab man growing up in Bethlehem. He was drawn to Hamas due to his resentment toward Israel, the IDF and the Israeli security wall. But when Habib got critically injured in a dove-hunting accident, he begged his family to take him to the IDF checkpoint where he knew of a kind Israeli soldier who allowed him quickly through and on to Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem.

Habib's hatred of Jews started to crumble when the Israeli hospital saved his life despite him being a Palestinian.

In the hospital, Habib had a dream of a shining man who said, "I love you, Habib." Soon the Bethlehem native came to embrace the Shining One who had also been born in Bethlehem. Habib has since become active in reconciliation between Jews and Arabs.

Disillusioned Gazan

Doyle, who was actually licensed to guide tours in Israel, also spent time in Gaza, where he befriended a young Muslim man named **Ali**. Ali's story expresses the disillusionment of millions of Muslims – with their political and religious leaders, with

Islam and with their lives. In Ali's case the "aha" moment happened when he saw the juxtaposition of Hamas with the <u>IDF</u> in the 2009 war in Gaza.

Ali said:

"What made me rethink my direction in life was the war with Israel... [the] IDF took precautions when they prepared to bomb a building. They sent text messages to civilian Palestinians warning them, 'Please get out immediately for your safety. We are not here to hurt you. We are only after Hamas.' But Hamas took advantage of the Israeli's care. They actually trapped people inside so 'bystanders' would be killed. They knew reports of the battle would make Israel look bad if civilians died... When I heard firsthand accounts of the brutally self-serving methods Hamas used against Israel — and us! — I could hardly believe it... [The IDF] soldiers were trying to protect Palestinians while Hamas wanted us dead. The Israelis outdid our people in being humane." (pg 197)

To encourage his friend Ali with hope, Doyle started to tell him stories of Jesus appearing to Muslims around the Middle East. Ali's response: "I would be honored to have a dream about Jesus."

Syrian secret policeman gets divinely interrogated

A Syrian believer named **Adel** tells how he got invited to interrogations often by the secret police, and how one of the secret police following him suddenly brought up dreams of Jesus:

"Mohammad had been assigned to follow me... After keeping a discreet distance for several days, Mohammad [the secret policeman] stopped me on the street one day and asked a question no interrogator had ever thrown at me... 'Why do you think I keep having dreams about Jesus?' ... Mohammad was shaken, I could tell. In most of the encounters, he explained, Jesus asked him questions... He did not know how to answer of course. The one question that haunted him the most was when Jesus asked, 'Mohammad, why are you persecuting Me?'" [pg 146; in a hotel room in Damascus of all places!]

Are Muslims receiving these special visitations for the very reason that they have received such a bad image due to terrorism? Perhaps it is to offset Arab feelings of shame and rejection that may go all the way back to Ishmael?

Honoring Muslims

Doyle says:

"Muslims have felt shame and dishonor since the time of Muhammad, but they don't feel shame when Jesus appears to them. It's quite the opposite. They feel honored that Jesus would come to them. After a visit from Jesus, Muslims, often say things like this:

'I felt loved on a level like I have never experienced.'

'I felt safe and protected.'

'I have never felt such a surge of joy and peace." (pg. 132)

What is left but to respond with amazement, as did Simon Peter at the house of the "un-kosher pagan" Roman centurion:
