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DISCUSSION GUIDE

OUR HOPE IN LIFE AND DEATH COLOSSIANS 3:1-17

- 1. Discuss the idea that "drawing near ignites new hope in our hearts but it also exposes hidden sin in our life." Have you found this to be true in your own experience?
- 2. What does it mean that "Christ is our life" (Col. 3:4)? How should this reality impact the way we live day-to-day?
- 3. The sermon talked about putting off what Christ put to death and putting on what Christ brought to life. What are some practical ways we can do this?
- 4. How does idolatry in the heart lead to damage in our relationships? Can you think of examples from your own life
- 5. "Killing sin won't cause salvation but it does confirm it." What is the relationship between fighting sin and eternal security?"
- 6. "To push worldly loves out pour the love of God in." Why is it never enough to just "remove" the bad. What's the point in replacing the old with something new?
- 7. What does it look like to show compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience and forgiveness in relationships, especially when it is difficult?
- 8. How have you experienced the transforming love of God in your own heart and relationships? In what areas do you still need to grow?
- 9. Of the three application points (lives guarded by peace, grounded in the Word, grateful for Christ's work), which one resonates most with you right now and why?
- 10. How do you plan to practically apply these truths this week?

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
