



## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Was there anything about the sermon today you'd like to discuss further? Anything that stuck out to you or that you wanted clarification on?
2. What has your experience been with debt? How can debt limit our freedom? What makes it so difficult to get/stay out of debt? Is going into debt "always" unwise? Why or why not? When would it be okay/wise to go into debt?
3. Do you believe you have extra? What makes it so difficult to think that we have extra? How did the message this morning encourage us to view our "extra?"
4. God calls the man in this parable a fool. He wasn't a fool because he was rich. He was a fool because he didn't know WHY he was rich. We're rich so that we can be "rich towards God." How do we do that, practically speaking?
5. Jesus gives at least one example of being "rich towards God" in Luke 12:33-34. Have you ever given to meet someone else's need? How did it make you feel? How do you meet the needs of others when giving to the church?
6. Pastor Wes mentioned the 3 P's of giving: priority, percentage, & progressive. Which of these would you like to grow in? What would that look like tomorrow?
7. Do you currently have a "giving plan?" A giving plan empowers you to be a 3 P giver. If you're willing, tell the group to hold you accountable to making a plan.
8. Read Proverbs 3:9-10. What does this verse teach us about giving? What does it promise us when we're obedient to give? Does this include financial blessing? Would you give if you knew without a doubt that God would bless it? Will he?
9. In light of today's message, what are some concrete and practical steps you will take today so that you apply the Word to your life? How can we help?
