

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS ROMANS 10:5-21 // CHOOSE TO LIVE A MISSIONAL LIFE

- 1. Was there anything about the message today that you found particularly helpful? Anything you'd like to discuss further?
- 2. Was there anything from our discussion last week that you'd like to report on? Did you act on any of your "next step" commitments? If so, tell us about it.
- 3. Pastor Wes shared an "everyday evangelism" strategy in today's message. What approach do you use? Why do you think having a plan/strategy is so important?
- 4. Living a missional life starts with missional prayers. How do you keep your heart broken over the unreached people in your life and those around the world? How do you pray for them on a consistent basis? What are good ideas to do it better?
- 5. God is always opening doors for us to engage in spiritual conversations. The key is keeping our eyes and ears open. What should you look for? What "key words" indicate an invitation for a spiritual conversation? How has this happened in the past?
- 6. Sharing a meal or cup of coffee seems to be a great medium for intimate conversations. Why do you think that is? What would you talk about during the meal to surface a spiritual conversation? What things should be avoided and why?
- 7. In the B.L.E.S.S. strategy, serving comes before sharing. Serving someone earns you the right to be heard. Share some practical ways you can serve people so that it opens up a pathway for spiritual conversations. What's the right motivation when doing so?
- 8. Eventually, a missional life leads to a verbal presentation of the Gospel. What does a biblical presentation of the Gospel contain? What's the most effective way to go about it? How do you do it personally? What things should be avoided and why?
- 9. In light of today's discussion, what are some practical next steps that you can take this week to apply God's Word to your life? How can we help you/pray for you so that you're successful in that effort?
