INCLUSIVE EXCLUCIVITY

ACTS 4:1-22

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Was there anything about the message today that was particularly helpful? Anything that you'd like to discuss further?
- 2. The exclusivity of Christianity troubles many people in our culture. How do you explain this concept with sharing the Christian faith today? What could we do better?
- 3. What is particularly troubling to the leaders about the apostles (v.7, 13-14), and what link is there between this distress and their rejection of the gospel message?
- 4. One of the key marks that you've been filled with the Holy Spirit is "boldness to share." Share times when you've been empowered by the Spirit with unusual boldness.
- 5. One of the things we learn from this passage is the certainty of persecution if we are obedient to share the biblical Gospel. How does this happen today?
- 6. The apostles seem to engage in a kind of "civil disobedience" due to their commitment to obey God rather than men. How does this happen today?
- 7. In the book of Acts you see that the Spirit comes and "refreshes" the apostles with new boldness and new courage. Are you in need of a "refreshing?" What do we learn from this text to help bring that about?
- 8. Our experience and knowledge of Christ are directly related to our effectiveness in sharing him. What needs to change in your life so you're better prepared?
- 9. What practical changes are you going to make in your life in light of today's discussion?
