- 1. When you were a child, who was your hero? Why did you admire that person?
- 2. What about today's sermon really stood out to you? What do you want to discuss?
- 3. How does an awareness of the nature of temptation help us fight it? Which temptation narcissism, hedonism, or materialism is most difficult for you?
- 4. Can you force someone to freely show love to another person? How else does secular society address this problem? What does Christianity say?
- 5. Why was Jesus angrier with religious hypocrites than with non-religious people? Read Matthew 23:23-28. Why did He call them "blind"? Why "vipers"?
- 6. How does reading about Christians who have suffered bring you encouragement? Whose stories have been particularly helpful for you?
- 7. Are you experiencing opposition because of your Christian faith? Are there things you could do to avoid it? Increase it? Which course of action should you take?
- 8. How does it help to know that the more closely we follow Christ, the more likely we will encounter opposition and persecution?
- 9. Which is more encouraging for you finding a person who is a good example to follow or knowing that the Holy Spirit empowers you to follow that example?
- 10. What are some practical changes you're going to make this week in light of today's message? How will you go about implementing them into your life?
