DISCUSSION QUESTIONS // ONE STEP AHEAD OF DEATH // 1 SAMUEL 20:3B

- 1. Was there anything about today's passage that you found particularly helpful? Is there anything you'd like to discuss further?
- 2. David said, "there is a step". What are some words to describe that step? Ex: "sure". Give Biblical references.
- 3. Read John 7:30, 8:20. Do you think what was true of Jesus; is it true for you? Why? How does it make you feel?
- 4. Read John 21:18-19. Do you think God knows the means of your death? Why? How does that make you feel?
- 5. Read John 11:21 and 32. How do you think Mary and Martha felt toward Jesus? What was their theology about time and means? What was Jesus teaching them about it?
- 6. Read John 11:33-38. What words describe Jesus' emotional response to this death experience? Why do you think He responded this way in light of what he was about to do?
- 7. Has there been a death that has affected your faith in Christ? How does this story help to heal hurts?
- 8. What has it been or what do you think it would be to see a "godly saint" die in great suffering? How should we view it in light of our Bible study?
- 9. Jesus died at 33 years saying, John 19:30 and Luke 23:46. He died "well". Why?
- 10. Do you think preparing to die frees you to live? How so?
- 11. Considering our discussion, what are one or two things you can start doing today (or this week) so that you practically apply the Word to your everyday life?
