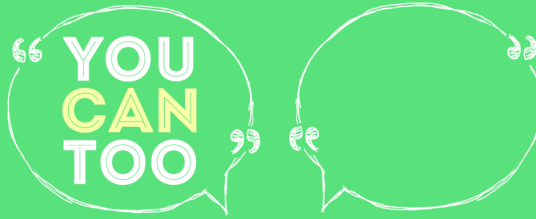

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Was there anything about today's passage that you found particularly helpful? Is there anything you'd like to discuss further?
2. Phillip had several reasons to avoid ministering to the Eunuch. Discuss these excuses & how similar types of excuses thwart our evangelistic efforts today.
3. The Lord had been preparing the Eunuch to hear and respond to the Gospel. He does the same thing today. What should we look for to know if God is opening a door for us to share the Gospel?
4. Biblical evangelism requires that we speak. We can "show" the Gospel with our life but we can only "share" it with our words. What elements/ideas make up a complete verbal presentation of the Gospel?
5. In explaining the Gospel, Phillip "started from that passage." All of the Old Testament points to Jesus. How did that passage specifically point to the Gospel? (cf. Isaiah 53) What about other passages in the OT?
6. Immediately after his conversation, the Eunuch was baptized. Baptism doesn't save us but it is important. Share about your baptism (if you've been baptized.) What was significant about that day?
7. Why do you think some people put off being baptized? What would you share from this passage to persuade them of baptism's importance?
8. What do we learn from this passage about being more effective in evangelism?
9. Considering today's discussion, what are one or two things you can start doing today (or this week) so that you practically apply the Word to your everyday life.
