



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS – LUKE 9:28-36

1. Was there anything about the message/passage today that you'd like to discuss further?
2. Today's message was about worship. If you had to define the word worship, what would you say and why?
3. Luke adds the detail that it was "about 8 days after these sayings" that Jesus went up on the mountain to pray with Peter, James and John. What were those "sayings?" Why are they important to this story?
4. The word translated "departure" in verse 31 is literally translated "exodus." How is the death of Jesus on the cross like the exodus of Israel from slavery in Egypt? What do you think Moses said to Jesus concerning his "exodus?"
5. What is the significance of Elijah the prophet being with Moses and Jesus?
6. In the message pastor Wes talked about worship as a form of "waking up" to the glory or weightiness of God. Share a time when the experience of God in worship "woke you up." What were the implications of that experience?
7. Peter immediately offers to build "three tents" for Jesus, Moses & Elijah. What do you think was going through his mind when he said that? Where was he right? Wrong?
8. When the voice comes out of the cloud and says, "this is my Son, my Chosen one; listen to him!" Moses and Elijah disappear. What's the significance of this? What's the significance of that saying today? Where is it most applicable in our culture? What about the church?
9. Share a time when your experience of God's presence resulted in a spiritual breakthrough.
10. What practical changes will you make to your life this week so that you can continue growing in your relationship with the Lord?
