



LUKE 10:1-16 // DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Was there anything about the sermon today you'd like to discuss further? Anything that stuck out to you or that you wanted clarification on?
2. Today's passage is similar to Luke's sending of the twelve in Luke 9:1-9. What similarities do you see? What differences stand out to you and why?
3. The message today offered several motivators for doing personal evangelism. Which one stood out the most to you and why?
4. The Lord is sovereign over the sending and saving of people according to his redemptive purposes. Discuss how the sovereignty of God should shape our view and approach to personal evangelism. How is this encouraging to you personally?
5. Jesus says we are sent out into a "plentiful harvest" as "lambs among wolves." How should those two things shape our approach to sharing the Gospel?
6. The reality of God's judgment on unbelief ought to be a powerful motivator for proclaiming the kingdom. What does your lifestyle say about your belief in the judgment on God? What should our lives look like if judgment is certain and true?
7. The message today also offered several methods on personal evangelism. Which one stood out most to you and why? Do you see any others in this passage?
8. Pastor Wes talked about "low hanging fruit" in personal evangelism. What should we look for when it comes identifying these kinds of people? What is the message Jesus told them to proclaim? What does that message consist of and why?
9. Jesus instructed his disciples to be diligent and avoid distractions on their evangelistic journey. What distractions keep us from being focused on evangelism today? What needs to change so that you can live on mission for the Lord?
