- 1. Was there anything about the sermon today you'd like to discuss further? Anything that stuck out to you or that you wanted clarification on?
- 2. Why do people join a small group? Why did you join this group? How has it impacted your spiritual life?
- 3. Pastor Wes said that small groups are the most effective and efficient means for spiritual growth as a disciple of Jesus. Do you agree or disagree?
- 4. Small groups aren't effective because of the biblical content that is shared but rather the biblical community that is forged. What make Christian community so unique and why is it so central to your spiritual growth?
- 5. Given how people grow spiritually, why are small groups so particularly effective at helping mature people in their Christian faith? How have groups helped you?
- 6. The Holy Spirit is the creator of and catalyst for Christian community. What does the Holy Spirit do so that real community is experienced in the church?
- 7. What are some ways we can undermine the Spirit's desire to create community? How can we protect ourselves from those liabilities in this small group?
