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DISCUSSION GUIDE

- 5. Reflect on the promises God made to Abraham How do they reflect God's grace, and what might these look like in light of the New Covenant we have under Christ?
- 6. Discuss the significance, symbolism and implications of circumcision as the covenant sign. What about the signs under the New Covenant? (Baptism/Communion)
- 7. How does this story illustrate the balance between God's grace and our response/obedience?
- 8. How does the New Covenant in Jesus fulfill & surpass God's covenant with Abraham? Discuss the implications of being part of this New Covenant community.
- 9. Are there areas in your life where you need to trust God's promises more deeply? If so where and what promise?
- 10. How does the concept of covenant community shape the understanding of our responsibilities towards one another? What does this look like under the New Covenant in Jesus?

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
