Luke 16:1-13

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Was there anything about the sermon today you'd like to discuss further? Anything that stuck out to you or that you wanted clarification on?
2. Read Luke 16:1-8. This parable is often misunderstood or misapplied. Why does the owner commend the money manager? What isn't commendable? What specifically are we encouraged to take away? What shouldn't we?
3. Read Luke 16:9. How have people used their money and/or their "worldly stuff" to make an eternal impact in your life? What difference did it make?
4. How have you used your personal wealth to make an eternal impact on someone else? How could you do so in the future? How could this take place through your giving to the local church or particular offerings in the church?
5. Read Luke 16:10-12. If God tested you on how you've managed his money, how would you grade yourself thus far? What changes could you make that would create the biggest difference in improving your grade?
6. Jesus suggests a correlation between faithful stewardship of what we have now and the potential of receiving more in the future. How have you seen this come true in your own life when it comes to personal finances?
7. Read Luke 16:13. What would your bank statement say about who/what you love most? What do your financial purchases say about your heart's devotion?
8. We ALL have a little bit of time & a little bit of money. We are accountable! How do we keep this truth in front of us when it comes to our finances/spending?
9. In light of today's message, what are some concrete and practical steps you will take today so that you apply the Word to your life? How can we help?
