DISCUSSION QUESTIONS Back to Bethel | Genesis 12:7-13:4

- 1. Have you ever been disappointed by someone you looked up to spiritually? How did you process this?
- 2. Share some personal trials that you've experienced. Did you sense any tendency towards fearful self-reliance instead of prayerful dependance? Discuss.
- 3. Spiritual compromise begins with a believable lie motivated by fear and/or greed. Has this ever happened in your life? Share a testimony of how you ended up in that place.
- 4. Spiritual compromise results in collateral damage. How have seasons of spiritual compromise in your life negatively impacted the people you love?
- 5. Abram's was stuck in a compromising position because of fear and material prosperity. Has this ever happened to you? What other things function as a snare in this way?
- 6. During seasons of compromise, have you seen God's promise/ plan for your life fade from view? Why did that happen? What removed that blindness from your eyes?
- 7. Share a testimony of God's faithfulness in your life. How has he kept you through difficult trials? Exposed you in your sin? Covered you with his mercy and grace?
- 8. What practical steps can you take to "turn away from Egypt" and "return to Bethel" in your walk with God? How can we pray and support you in that decision?
