



## How May We Serve You?

Acts 6:1-7; 1 Timothy 3:8-13

**Acts 6:1-4, But as the believers rapidly multiplied, there were rumblings of discontent. The Greek-speaking believers complained about the Hebrew-speaking believers, saying that their widows were being discriminated against in the daily distribution of food. 2 So the Twelve called a meeting of all the believers. They said, “We apostles should spend our time teaching the Word of God, not running a food program. 3 And so, brothers, select seven men who are well respected and are full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will give them this responsibility. 4 Then we apostles can spend our time in prayer and teaching the word.”**

### I. God expects us to examine a man's character. Acts 6:3

**Acts 6:3, ... select seven men who are well respected and are full of the Spirit and wisdom.**

### B. Give evidence of being Spirit-filled.

**Ephesians 5:18, Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit,**

**1 Timothy 3:8, ...not given to much wine...**

**Proverbs 23:31-33, Do not look on the wine when it is red, When it sparkles in the cup, When it swirls around smoothly; 32 At the last it bites like a serpent, And stings like a viper. 33 Your eyes will see strange things, And your heart will utter perverse things.**



For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; (Titus 1:7 KJV)

Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise. (Prov 20:1 KJV)

### II. God expects us to examine a man's conduct.

Acts 6:1; 1 Timothy 3:8-13

**1 Timothy 3:8-9, Likewise deacons must be reverent, not double-tongued, not given to much wine, not greedy for money, 9 holding the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience. NKJV**



Deacons must not be double-tongued.  
1 Timothy 3:8

**Matthew 18:15, "If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back.**

**1 Timothy 3:10, But let these also first be tested; then let them serve as deacons, being found blameless. NKJV**

**1 Timothy 3:11, Likewise, their wives must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things. 12 Let deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well. NKJV**

**2 Corinthians 5:17, Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have parasitic infection more have no idea passed away; behold, all things have become new.**

**1 Timothy 3:13, For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a good standing and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus. NKJV**

**Acts 6:7, So God's message continued to spread. The number of believers greatly increased in Jerusalem, and many of the Jewish priests were converted, too.**
